

## Gunner's Circle, South Africa

**Type:** Street Circuit

**Length:** 3.250 Miles / 5.230 km

**Used:** 2 January 1951 - 1 January 1958

Situated in the Epping Industrial Area 10 km East of the Cape Town City Center. This circuit was built in the latter part of 1950 and covered a distance of 3 miles and 440 yards. The first race took place on 2 January 1951 and races were regularly held until the final meeting on 1 January 1958. The promoters were unable to obtain further permission to use this circuit due to increasing industrial development in the area at that particular time. Today this area is home to hundreds of prominent factories, workshops and other industrial related businesses. The areas to the north and west are residential areas, while a highway flanks the eastern border. A railway line is situated to the south.
