

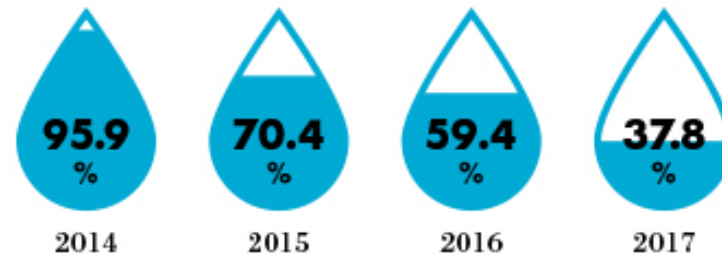
THE FUTURE OF WATER IS IN ALL OUR HANDS
