## COVID-19 update

On Monday, 1 February 2021 the [Adjusted Level 3 regulations](#) were relaxed in response to declining COVID-19 daily infections. However, the number of people infected remains high and we need to keep following all health and safety protocols to ensure that the virus does not resurge again. Please ensure that you practice social distancing and wear a mask at all times.

### Summary of changes to Adjusted Level 3 regulations:

- **Revised curfew:** The curfew has been relaxed and residents are required to be at home from 23:00 – 04:00 daily.
- **Early closing times:** All businesses, including restaurants and bars, must close by 22:00.
- **Alcohol sales:** The sale, distribution and transportation of alcohol is unbanned. Retail off-sales of alcohol is permitted between 10:00 and 18:00 on Monday to Thursday only.
- **Beaches, parks and public swimming pools:** All beaches, parks and public swimming pools, including those in enclosed resorts, are open to the public.
- **Gatherings:** Outdoor gatherings are limited to 100 persons. Indoor gatherings as well as religious gatherings and funerals are limited to 50 persons.
- **Masks:** Wearing a mask in public remains compulsory and failure to comply is an offence punishable by law, and may result in a fine and/or imprisonment of up to six months.
