

**MONDAY 26/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Fire**

At approximately **06:20** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was on his way to a standoff zone he noticed a fire on Viking Way at the informal settlement, he confirmed that Fire and Rescue, SAPS as well as an Ambulance were on the scene. He confirmed that there was one person injured and no deaths were reported, the patient was taken to a hospital.

**SUNDAY 25/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Workers in Epping**

At approximately **10:16** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a construction truck on the buffer between the Langa railway line and Gunners Circle. The truck was busy off-loading railway concrete sleepers, the ECID Public Safety Officer spoke with the supervisor who was from PRASA and he confirmed that they came to rebuild the railway tracks.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Missing Drain Cover**

At approximately **09:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an open drain in Cochrane Avenue, the officer reported this to the ECID CCTV Controller who contacted the City of Cape Town and a reference number was given.

**TUESDAY 27/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Insecure Building**

At approximately **11:05** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was busy with patrols in Gunners Circle, he noticed that the back window of a company was left wide open, he checked around the building and noted that no one was on site, The officer then tried to contact the owner but was unsuccessful.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Leak-Drain**

At approximately **13:44** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a leaking drain on the corner of Gunners Circle and Evans Avenue, she contacted the City of Cape Town and was given a reference number.

At approximately **21:31** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted a City of Cape Town vehicle putting danger tape around the area of the leak. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that they are attending to the leak.

**THURSDAY 22/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Public Assistance**

At approximately **12:00** an ECID Public Safety Officers reported a truck that lost its load of 30 x 20 litres of paint cans, the officer spoke with the driver who informed him that the truck lost the load due to the ropes coming loose, the ECID Public Safety Officers assisted by controlling the traffic.

The ECID Public Safety Officers were informed and requested to do regular patrols as this area is one of the hotspots.

**TUESDAY 20/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Suspicious Vehicles**

At approximately **07:30** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a truck and a private vehicle exchanging containers. ECID Public Safety Officers responded and spoke with the truck driver who confirmed that everything was fine. His manager came to fetch diesel to fill up one of their trucks that was stuck without fuel.

**Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **08:25** an ECID Public Safety Officer came across an accident that occurred on Bofors Circle. SAPS and Ambulance services were on the scene and the injured person was taken to hospital.

**THURSDAY 15/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Possession of Suspected Stolen Property**

At approximately **12:00** while the ECID Security Liaison Officer and an ECID Public Safety Officer were driving in Moorsom Avenue, they noticed four individuals pulling a flat trolley on the rails, the trolley was loaded with four roof racks. It was alleged by the individuals that they picked up the roof racks, since the suspects were not the lawful owners, they were informed that the property is going to be confiscated. An investigation was conducted where various companies were visited to see if the racks belonged to them. As no one identified the racks were then taken to ECID Office

**SATURDAY 03/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Assault (Arrest)**

At approximately **16:20** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Gunners Circle he noticed two individuals fighting in the middle of the road, both were in possession of dangerous weapons. The ECID Public Safety Officer then called for backup and requested the ECID CCTV Controller to contact SAPS.

SAPS and ECID Public Safety Officers were able to stop the fight, one individual was wounded on the left arm, both individuals were taken to a Police Station.

**SUNDAY 18/04/2021**




**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**SAPS Assistance (Arrest)**

At approximately **09:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer requested backup to assist SAPS who were chasing three suspects who had allegedly robbed a member of public.

The suspects were crossing the railway tracks from Benbow Avenue to Fisher Avenue. The ECID Public Safety Officers managed to assist SAPS to arrest suspects.

**MONDAY 12/03/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft (Recovery and Warning)**

At approximately **01:50** The ECID CCTV Controller received an anonymous phone call where she was informed about theft in progress in Packer Avenue where it was alleged that two suspects were busy stealing electric cable, she then relayed the information to the ECID Public Safety Officers responded and found two suspects in possession of cables.

A Security officer arrived on the scene and phoned the client who informed him that he cannot come out due to the curfew time, the client then instructed him to take the cables back to the yard and release both suspects with a warning.

**WEDNESDAY 07/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft (Items Recovered)**

At approximately **04:03** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from an individual who informed him about theft that was in progress in Bertie Avenue. The individual further explained that one suspect was busy stealing red boat covers. ECID Public Safety Officers quickly responded to the address and found no suspect, only two red boat covers outside the yard left/dropped next to the gate. The ECID Public Safety Officer then took the covers to the ECID Office. Later in the day at approximately **13:24** the ECID Public Safety Officer delivered the covers back to the lawful owner.

**MONDAY 05/04/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Yard**

At approximately **15:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer was approached by an individual who informed him about a theft that took place, his vehicle's rear left window was broken to gain access to his vehicle cover. During the interview, the individual alleged that he parked his vehicle at approximately **05:30** in the yard at his work place, at approximately **15:00** when he came off duty, he found his vehicle broken into. The ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS who informed her that their vehicles were all out on calls and it might take time before they could attend to the incident. The ECID Public Safety Officer then advised the complainant to go to the police station to report the incident as he required a case number for his insurance
