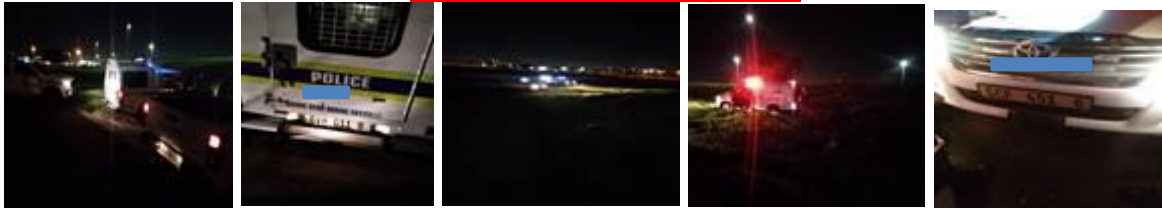


WEDNESDAY 04/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Death

At approximately **18:20** an ECID Public Safety Officer was approached by a member of public who reported an individual who appeared to have passed away. An ECID Public Safety Officer went to check and requested an ECID CCTV Controller to contact SAPS who arrived at approximately **21:10** as well as the Ambulance services who arrived at approximately **22:55** and declared the homeless individual dead. The inquest docked was opened and the body was taken away by the state pathology who arrived at approximately **23:45**.

TUESDAY 03/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Armed Robbery

At approximately **12:36** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a security officer requesting ECID assistance with an armed robbery that took place in Bertie Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and spoke with the complainant who informed him that he was robbed of his cash at gun point by two individuals, SAPS was called.

TUESDAY 03/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft of Copper Cable

At approximately **07:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported the theft of copper cable from a street light in Bofors Circle opposite Moorsom Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer lodged a service request on the City of Cape Town's website where a reference number was generated.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT-CCTV

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **13:34** an ECID CCTV assistant spotted an accident at the Viking Way traffic lights. robots. An ECID Public Safety Officer attended to the accident where two vehicles collided. Both vehicles were towed away and there were no serious injuries.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft

At approximately **14:10** an CCTV Assistant received a phone call from an informer wrt three individuals that stole a drain cover on Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, the individuals were not found and the drain cover was gone. An ECID CCTV Controller then contacted the City of Cape Town regarding the matter and a reference number was given.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft /Business Assistance

At approximately **12:28** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a security company in Bofors Circle requesting ECID assistance with an individual who stole goods from their client's vehicle. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and the individual was found in possession of the stolen goods and the suspect was then handed to the security company. No case was opened.

THURSDAY 26/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft/Discovery of City Property

At approximately **10:55** an ECID CCTV Assistant received a phone call from an informer wrt two individuals in Bofors Circle, who were pulling a trolley loaded with drain covers. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, on their arrival, the individuals left the trolley and ran towards Elsie's River. The trolley was confiscated as well as two drain covers.

THURSDAY 26/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft (Arrest)

At approximately **10:30** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a company owner requesting the ECID to contact SAPS as there are suspects in possession of reported stolen stainless steel. An ECID CCTV Assistant contacted SAPS and ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and assisted SAPS with the suspects. The suspects were arrested and SAPS confiscated the stainless steel.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT-CCTV

Attempted Theft

At approximately **18:07** an ECID CCTV assistant spotted two suspicious individuals on the railway tracks. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, on their arrival the suspicious individuals ran away. The ECID Public Safety Officers noticed that the individuals removed slabs and the security on site was informed.

FRIDAY 27/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft/Discovery of City Property

At approximately **12:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed two individuals who were pushing a trolley loaded with two drain covers and called for backup, on their arrival, the individuals left the trolley and ran towards Elsie's River. The trolley as well as the covers were confiscated.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Possession of Suspected Stolen Property (Cable)

At approximately **06:50** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from an informer wrt an individual who was walking in Kinghall Avenue carrying a large cable. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and on their arrival the individual dropped the cable and ran away to Bonteheuwel Station. The suspected stolen property was taken to the ECID Office where the ECID Public Safety Officer completed the confiscation book.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT-CCTV

Suspicious Activity/Confiscation of a Wheelie Bin

At approximately **12:40** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted three suspicious individuals on the buffer between Gunners Circle and Langa railway line. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, on their arrival they found the individuals pushing a wheelie bin full of sand. ECID Public Safety Officers then informed the individuals the reason they approached them and the wheelie bin was confiscated.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Confiscation of a Trolley

At approximately **22:45** An ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a suspicious individual pushing a trolley in Gerry Ferry Crescent and tried to approach the individual who ran away and left the trolley. The empty trolley was confiscated.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **23:58** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a fire on Viking Way at the informal settlement. The ECID Public Safety Officer reported that Fire and Rescue was already on the scene. The supervisor confirmed that there were no injuries reported and that two shacks burnt down. Fire and Rescue managed to extinguish the fire.

TUESDAY 10/08/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident-WPP

At approximately **09:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an accident in Agric street involving two vehicles. The Officer attempted to gather information, but both drivers did not want to give their information and they then drove away in another vehicle without saying anything to the ECID Public Safety Officer.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT-CCTV

Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **07:02** an ECID CCTV Assistant spotted SAPS and a security officer attending to an individual who was lying down opposite a company on Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, on his arrival SAPS left the scene and it was confirmed by the pedestrian that he was knocked by the vehicle that left the scene after the police took the drivers details. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted an ambulance and the pedestrian was taken to the hospital.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Damage to Property

At approximately **11:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed broken slabs at the back of a company adjacent to the railway tracks and went to inform the manager who confirmed that their truck reversed and accidentally knocked down the slabs. An ECID Public Safety Officer advised the manager to close the opening as it will draw the attention of criminals. The manager immediately closed the opening.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Leaking Drain

At approximately **08:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported an overflowing drain in Moody Crescent. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted the City of Cape Town and was given a reference number. At approximately **12:10** a representative of the City of Cape Town arrived to attend the complaint and the leak was fixed.

At approximately time **10:39** and ECID CCTV Controller spotted a construction company working on Admiral Close. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched to investigate, the supervisor confirmed that they came to clean the drains.

SUNDAY 08/08/2021

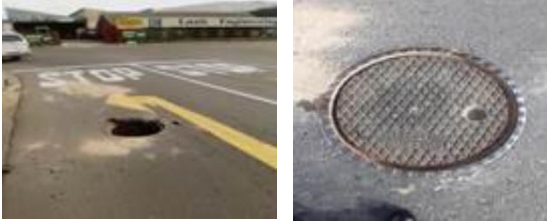


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Missing Drain Cover

At approximately **13:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported a missing drain cover in Carrier Way. An ECID Public Safety Officer logged a service request on the City of Cape Town's website and a reference number was generated. At approximately **15:45** the ECID Security Liaison Officer and a ECID Public Safety Officer took one of the confiscated covers and covered/closed the open drain.

Faulty Street Lights

At approximately **10:05** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that street lights on Bofors Circle are not working. An ECID CCTV Controller logged a service request on the City of Cape Town's website and a reference number was generated.
