

**SUNDAY 13/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Fire**

At approximately **19:38** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted fire opposite Gunners 24 on the buffer between Epping 1 and Langa. The ECID CCTV Assistant Controller contacted Fire and Rescue who dispatched a vehicle and extinguished the fire.

**TUESDAY 22/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Damaged Street Light**

At approximately **09:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that in front of number 7 Cochrane Avenue there was a street light that has been knocked down. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted the City of Cape Town and was given a reference number, the complaint was forwarded to the street lights department.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Burst Water Pipe**

At approximately **14h45** an ECID Security Liaison Officer reported a burst water pipe burst in Gerry Ferry Crescent. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted City of Cape Town to log a C3, they promised to have it repaired within 48 hours.

On Saturday 19/12/2020 at approximately **16:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer noted that the pipe was repaired.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Business Assistance**

At approximately **00:10** the ECID Public Safety Officer in WPP noted that the gate at a company in Cable Close was not locked. The manager was contacted and confirmed that he would lock the gate.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Business Assistance**

At approximately **08:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a truck standing in Dacres Avenue in front a company's gate with its load half off, the driver informed him that he was turning in Dacres Avenue the load start falling off the truck and he decided to stop and wait for assistance. The Manager from the company in Dacres Avenue arrived and informed the Public Safety Officer that they will offload the truck where it is, the ECID Public Safety Officer assisted with traffic

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Animal Assistance**

At approximately **11:17** an ECID Public Safety Officers noticed a horse on Bofors Circle on the open field, that was lying down and struggling to get up. The ECID Manager was informed and she confirmed that she will phone CHPA. At approximately **11:37** an inspector from CHPA arrived, by then the horse was on its feet, the inspector confirmed that he will go to look for the owner so that he can come check the horse.

**Abandoned Wheelie bins**

At approximately **20:12** the ECID Public Safety Officer in Western Province Park, noticed two abandoned wheelie bins in Mail Street. Both bins were removed and placed out of sight, next to the iron fence.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Workers in Epping**

At approximately **12:25** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that the City of Cape Town were busy repairing a fire hydrant in Gerry Ferry Avenue.

**WEDNESDAY 02/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **11:30** two ECID Public Safety Offices attended to an accident on Bofors Circle. The Public Safety officers assisted with traffic control while waiting for SAPS and Traffic Officials to arrive. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, Fire and Rescue as well as the Ambulance Services as there was a seriously injured person. A case docket of reckless and negligent driving with injuries was opened and the patient was taken to a hospital in Pinelands.

**THURSDAY 10/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Suspicious Activity**

At approximately **19:24** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a suspicious male in the rail siding and despatched ECID Public Safety Officers and the quad bikes who found the suspicious male walking on the rails, the ECID Public Safety Officers requested permission to search the male, permission was granted, nothing was found on him. He was warned him and instructed to leave the area.

## THURSDAY 03/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Suspicious Vehicle**

At approximately **15:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a tip off from an anonymous person about a suspicious vehicle that was parked at Langa Station where three armed suspects exited the vehicle and ran over Langa. One of the suspects then returned and removed the vehicle license disc.

The ECID Security Liaison Officer phoned SAPS, SAPS arrived together with a member of the K9 unit, the vehicle was searched and circulated. The vehicle had been stolen and was the same one used in the armed robbery the previous day on Jakes Gerwel Drive near the Gunners/Bofors Circle traffic lights.

## WEDNESDAY 23/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Dumping**

At approximately **07:54** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted a truck offloading sand on the buffer between Gunners Circle and Epping 1 opposite Evans Avenue, an ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and he spoke to a gentleman from City of Cape Town who confirmed that they are offloading sand and they will come back to collect it.

## SUNDAY 20/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Stop & Search**

At approximately **23:46** ECID Public Safety Officers assisted Pinelands SAPS conducting a stop and search on Gunners Circle, a black Hyundai Gertz with five african males was searched. Pinelands SAPS found nothing illegal in the vehicle and they were released with a verbal warning for breaking curfew hours.

**WEDNESDAY 16/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Suicide**

At around **18:12** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by member of the public notifying him about a person who was attempting to commit suicide by jumping in front of a moving vehicles opposite a company in Gunners Circle. ECID Public Safety Officers responded immediately and managed to corner the person who was attempting to kill himself. The gentleman was detaining until SAPS arrived on the scene. When asked why he wanted to take his own life; his response was that he's fed up with life and he doesn't want to live anymore. He was taken by the SAPS officials who attended the scene to Langa SAPS.

**WEDNESDAY 02/12/2020**




**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft**

At approximately **03:23** ECID Public Safety Officers who were doing their patrols in the Elliot/Fitzmaurice rail siding reported that they noticed fresh footprints and called back up. Two ECID Public Safety Officers responded, on their arrival they found alcohol. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived immediately and took statements. No arrests were made.

**MONDAY 28/12/2020**




**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Break-In**

At approximately **08:57** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from no. 13 Hewett Avenue requiring the ECID's assistance wrt two suspects inside of their premises. The ECID Public Safety Officers responded but the two suspects were already fleeing in the direction of Bonteheuwel on the buffer between Epping 2 and Bonteheuwel. It was alleged by the security officer on duty that the alarm was activated and made a loud noise, the two suspects jumped back out and ran away without taking anything.

**THURSDAY 24/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Suicide**

At approximately **17:13** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a lady who requested the ECID's assistance at number 21 Benbow Avenue as her father's vehicle was parked outside the building and he was not answering his cell phone or office phone. Two Public Safety Officers responded and found the building locked; the gate guard contacted the manager who gave him the password to open the door. The ECID Public Safety Officers entered as per the request of the gentleman's daughter and went in to the garage where her father's other vehicle was idling and the ECID Public Safety Officer noticed that the gentleman seemed to have passed out, he also noticed that there was a short piece of hose pipe in the exhaust pipe, the pipe did not reach the window of the vehicle due to the shortness of the hose pipe. An ECID CCTV Controller was requested to phone SAPS, Fire and Rescue and the Ambulance Service. At approximately **17:53** the ambulance arrived and the gentleman was declared dead at the scene. SAPS arrived at **17:55** and took over the scene. It was confirmed by SAPS that an inquest docket would be opened and the deceased will be collected by the office of the state pathologist.

**TUESDAY 01/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Hijacking & Mugging**

At approximately **21:01** an ECID Public Safety who was doing his patrols in Bofors Circle, approaching Packer Avenue, he noticed a member of the public standing next to his vehicle with hazards on and waved the ECID vehicle down seeking help. The complainant explained that he had just being mugged by three male suspects with a knife and they fled scene using a green Fiat Uno. The complainant also explained that the suspect's vehicle initially blocked his car while he was coming out of Packer Avenue, the three suspects got out of their car and robbed him of his money and attempted to take his vehicle, luckily another vehicle came pass and the suspects fled from scene. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS whom insisted that the complainant is to drive to the Police Station to open a case which he did.

**TUESDAY 22/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Workers in Epping**

At approximately **11:21** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that while patrolling Fitzmaurice Avenue he noticed a Fire and Rescue service vehicle. The supervisor in charge confirmed that they are servicing and doing maintenance on the fire hydrants around Epping.

**WEDNESDAY 02/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Armed Robbery & Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **15:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a vehicle accident on Jakes Gerwel Drive near the Gunners/Bofors Circle traffic lights involving a truck and a car. On arrival, the Public Safety Officer spoke with both drivers and the truck driver confirmed that he was held up by two suspects with a gun who were driving white VW and he lost control of the truck when the two suspects entered his truck and robbed him of R 30 000. The suspects fled the scene going in the direction of Gunners Circle. The ECID CCTV Controller checked the footage on the LPR camera and noticed that the incident took place at approximately **14:30**.

**FRIDAY 04/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Trespassing & Theft**

At approximately **13:00** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a company requesting ECID assistance, there were suspects on the premises running towards the rail siding with 30 banana crates with a value of R 250.00 each. ECID Public Safety Officers responded to close off all possible exits, one suspect was arrested in the yard and all the crates were recovered. The company confirmed that they will not open a case against the suspect who was giving a stern warning by an ECID Public Safety Officer and then released.

## THURSDAY 17/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Theft**

At around **04:12** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company who needed assistance as there was a theft in progress at Elliot Avenue. The complainant gave a full description of the suspect's vehicle that was in Elliot Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller spotted the vehicle fleeing out of the Elliot Avenue, the ECID Public Safety Officers gave chase and managed to corner the vehicle in Bofors Circle, there was only a driver inside the vehicle.

SAPS were contacted as per request of the client. The vehicle was searched and alcohol was found. The driver was requested to drive back to Elliot Avenue and he complied without any complications. A case was opened and the suspect was taken to the police station for further processing and profiling together with the owner of the vehicle.

## WEDNESDAY 23/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Mugging**

At around **17:38** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a complaint about two suspects who had just robbed a member of the public in Moorsom Avenue under the trees, of 1 cell phone and an undisclosed amount of cash. Two ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched but the two suspects were already gone, heading in the direction of Bonteheuwel Station. The victim insisted that he would like to go to the Police Station by himself to open a case.

## SUNDAY 27/12/2020



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Theft from a Motor Vehicle**

At approximately **08:54** an ECID Public Safety Officer who was patrolling in Cochrane Avenue decided to check if everything was ok with one of the truck drivers who was parked there. The truck driver came out and realized that three PVC tarpaulins for the back trailers were gone. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted Pinelands SAPS as per the request of the truck driver. At about **11:49** SAPS arrived and assisted the complainant to open a criminal case.

**FRIDAY 25/12/2020**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Assault**

At approximately **18:50** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a member of the public being assaulted by an unknown male who robbed him of his bag. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted the Ambulance Department. At approximately **19:30** Fire and rescue arrived and dressed the complainants wound with a bandage; the complainant then walked to hospital for medical assistance.
