DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Leak-Water Valve

At approximately **07:43** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported a water valve leak in Christian Avenue.

An ECID CCTV Controller contacted CoCT to report the leak. On Monday 08/02/2021 an ECID Public Safety Officer noted that the leak had been repaired.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **15:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported a fire at Nourse Avenue and the fire was in danger of spreading. The ECID CCTV Controllers called Fire and Rescue. Law Enforcement were already on the scene and requested the ECID Public Safety Officers to close the road for incoming traffic due an explosion.

At approximately **16:15** the situation was stabilised and the fire was extinguished at approximately **16:49**.

Workers-WPP

At approximately **11:40** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling he noticed contractors working in Park Road. He spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that they were installing fibre cables.

Damaged Street Light

At approximately **21:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer was on patrol in Fisher Avenue where he noticed a damaged street light pole on the circle. He requested an ECID CCTV Controller to contact CoCT to report the light and obtain a reference number.

At approximately **12:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an open drain in the middle of the circle in Cochrane Avenue.

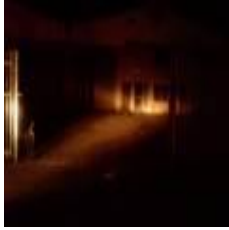
DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fallen Load

At approximately **11:25** an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling on Bofors Circle, when he noticed a vehicle that had lost its load opposite the garage on the corner of Goodenough Avenue. The Officer spoke with the driver who confirmed that the vehicle lost its load due to the ropes not being correctly secured.

The Officer placed orange cones to assist with traffic control as the vehicle caused an obstruction in the road, the officer also assisted them to reload the vehicle.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Insecure Premises-WPP

At approximately **22:15**, while patrolling in Agric Street, WPP the ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an open gate, he checked to see if there was anything suspicious and if there was a contact number of the owner or armed response. Nothing suspicious was noted. The Officer requested the ECID CCTV Controller to call the owner but the CCTV Controller was unable to make contact with the owner.

The ECID Public Safety Officer then conducted regular patrols.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **16:57** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company on Bofors Circle, requesting ECID assistance with an accident that had occurred in front of their company.

The ECID Officer dispatched another ECID Public Safety Officer to the scene where the Officer assisted with traffic control.

The ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS, Ambulance as well as Fire and Rescue. SAPS did not arrive on the scene and the pedestrian was taken to a private doctor by her father.

TUESDAY 16/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **19:10** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company in Benbow Avenue requesting ECID's assistance with an accident.

Two ECID Public Safety Officers responded and, on their arrival, they found a vehicle that had knocked a street light pole and then driven into the wall. The owner of the building did not wish to involve SAPS.

An ECID CCTV Controller contacted the CoCT to report the light and obtain a reference number.

FRIDAY 12/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Squatter-WPP

At approximately **08:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a small structure on the buffer at Viking Way and went to investigate. The ECID Public Safety Officer confirmed that he found one homeless male, the officer requested the male to remove his structure but he did not cooperate. The ECID Public Safety Shift Senior instructed the Officers to give the man time to move his belongings. At approximately **12:30** three ECID Public Safety Officers then went to destroy the structure as the homeless did not destroy it when he left.

SUNDAY 21/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Squatters

At approximately **15:30** the ECID Security Liaison Officer reported an illegal structure on Viking Way behind the Fire Station, the ECID CCTV Controller despatched an ECID Public Safety Officer to investigate. One illegal structure was found behind the Fire Station with homeless people in it. The Officer cautiously requested them to remove it, they complied without any difficulties.

TUESDAY 02/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Stop and Search-Warning Issued

At approximately **02:12** the ECID CCTV Controller noticed four suspects walking on Bofors Circle carrying heavy bags, she then despatched ECID Public Safety Officers, who responded and cautiously surrounded the suspects. The suspects were searched with the help of Law Enforcement who were passing by. Tools that were found on them were confiscated by Law Enforcement. All suspects were warned, released and escorted out of the area.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Drunk & Disorderly

At approximately **00:55** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was on the buffer between Langa railway line and Gunners Circle he noticed a male individual wondering around on the buffer.

When the male noticed that the ECID Public Safety Officer was approaching him, he started running towards Langa Bridge. The ECID Public Safety Officer tried to stop him but he ignored the Officer and changed direction, he then turned again towards Langa Bridge but he fell alongside the road just after the of Gunners Circle / Bofors Circle intersection and then passed out.

The ECID Public Safety Officer tried to assess him and noticed that he was under the influence of alcohol to the extent that he could not talk.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, who arrived at approximately **01:35** and confirmed that the male individual was under the influence of alcohol and they will have to wait until he wakes up before they can act. SAPS then searched him and found one Samsung Galaxy smart phone and a small Nokia phone on him.

While the ECID Public Safety Officers were waiting for SAPS to return, the male individual woke up and ran to the railway tracks and disappeared into the new informal settlement near Langa Bridge. SAPS handed over the male's phones to the ECID Public Safety Officer.

MONDAY 15/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Public Assistance/Assault

At approximately **01:10** two ECID Public Safety Officers reported that they were informed about a male victim that was attacked and left wounded on railway lines opposite Fisher Avenue.

Four ECID Public Safety Officers responded and found the victim, who is a staff taxi driver. The victim confirmed that he was here to pick up staff but he doesn't know why he ended up on the railway lines. The ECID Public Safety Officer went to Fisher Avenue and found the victim's Quantum parked in Fisher Avenue by the circle and it was locked.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue, Ambulance and the owner of the Quantum, the owner arrived and confirmed that he does not have a spare key, but will attend to the Quantum the next morning. The victim was taken to hospital.

THURSDAY 04/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft Yard-Warning Issued

At approximately **13:10** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company requesting ECID assistance with suspects that are in their yard with the intention to steal iron steel.

The ECID Public Safety Officer dispatched two ECID Public Safety Officers and confirmed that on their arrival three suspects were kept in the premises.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS as per the request of the complainant.

At approximately **14:08** the ECID Public Safety Officer confirmed that the complainant requested SAPS to be cancelled as he is not interested in attending court. The suspects were warned and released.

SUNDAY 07/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Armed Robbery

At approximately **23:56** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company in Christian Avenue informing him about an armed robbery that had occurred a few minutes earlier.

Three ECID Public Safety Officers responded, on their arrival they were informed that a white truck and a Quantum with eight suspects had robbed the company's Security Officers at gun point. During the interview it was alleged that the suspects tied the Security Officers with cables ties and demanded the key for gate 1, they then accessed the premises and loaded copper onto the truck. On their way out one suspect took the car keys from the Security Supervisor and got away with his vehicle.

The ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS, a Detective and Photographer arrived at approximately **00:18**. A case of armed robbery was opened.

An ECID Public Safety Officer conducted a camera investigation and the feedback was given to the company by the ECID Manager.

THURSDAY 18/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft Building

At approximately **08:58** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a company in Moorsom Avenue informing the ECID about an attempted theft that took place at their business premises.

Two ECID Public Safety Officers were sent to investigate, on arrival they spoke with the complainant and it was discovered that one of the office members forgot to close a window, due to this negligence, the suspect saw the opportunity to gain entry.

Nothing was stolen as it was alleged that one of the site Security Officers noticed the suspect at approximately **04:45** and called for the other officers, the suspect ran away and dropped the property he tried to steal.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft Building-Arrest

At approximately **05:55** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a Security Service working at a company in Elliot Avenue, The ECID was informed about a suspect that was in their yard.

ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and they confirmed that there was one suspect in the company's warehouse busy stripping down copper cables and air conditioners.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **06:44**, the suspect was handed over to SAPS, arrested and taken to the Police Station.

TUESDAY 23/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Intimidation

At approximately **18:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer was approached by four suspects who told him that the ECID Public Safety Officers must not interfere with them when they are stealing from the demolished premises in Losack & Kinghall Avenues. All suspects alleged that they had been arrested for this.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS informing them about the situation, SAPS confirmed that in case of any emergency or if the suspects are identified around the area, SAPS must be informed.

SUNDAY 14/02/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft Building

Approximately at **07:49** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call informing him about a suspected break-in at 124 Gunners Circle.

ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and confirmed that on their arrival they found two front windows broken and noticed that the cash register inside the premises appeared to have been tampered with.

While the ECID Public Safety Officers searched outside the building, they found sticks that appeared to have been used to hook the cash register.

Both client and SAPS were contacted, the complainant's statement was taken by SAPS and a case was opened.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft Road/Yard-Arrest

At approximately **04:44** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Gerry Ferry Crescent he noticed a trolley lying around and went to investigate. He found out that two batteries were stolen out of a truck. The ECID Public Safety Officer then notified the Security Officer who was not aware of the incident.

Two ECID Public Safety Officers went to investigate at the informal market settlement and received information about three suspects that stole the batteries from garage, they then went to one of the suspect's shacks to check if they could find anything.

On arrival at one suspect's place, two batteries were recovered, the ECID Public Safety Officers took the batteries back to garage.

SAPS was not contacted as the driver confirmed that he will wait for his office to open so that he can enquire if he must open a case or not.
