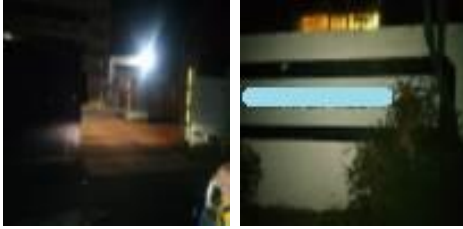


WEDNESDAY 20/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Insecure Premises**

At approximately **23:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a gate left open in Evans Avenue, Epping 1. The ECID Public Safety Officer managed to get in touch with the client who requested the ECID Officers assistance with closing the gate, the client advised on how to close the gate manually. Two ECID Public Safety Officers closed the gate and left premises safe.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Damage to Property**

At approximately **09:10** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Christian Avenue, Epping 2 he noticed a truck whose diesel tank had been vandalised and the diesel had spilled out to the road.

The ECID Public Safety Officer confirmed that the truck has been parked there for few days and the driver is unknown.

WEDNESDAY 13/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Stop and Search (Warning Issued)**

At approximately **00:23** two ECID Public Safety Officers requested permission to conduct a search on a suspect who was busy roaming in Packer Avenue, Epping 2. Permission was granted and nothing suspicious was found in his possession and the ECID Public Safety Officers warned him to leave the area, which he did without incident.

TUESDAY 05/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Squatters

At approximately **06:43** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed the structure on the buffer between Bofors Circle and Bonteheuwel railway tracks, Epping 2. Two ECID Public Safety Officers were called for backup while the ECID CCTV Controller contacted Law Enforcement. At approximately **08h18** Law Enforcement arrived and confirmed that they are just taking pictures and will return with a truck to destroy and load the structure. At approximately **14:30** four ECID Public Safety Officers went to destroy the structure as per the instruction from Law Enforcement.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Trespassing (Arrest)

At approximately **09:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from the ECID Manager regarding a client that required ECID assistance at a company in Dacres Avenue, Epping 2

ECID Public Safety Officers responded, on arrival it was alleged that a suspect had entered the premises and then run off when he saw the client and security approaching. The ECID Public Safety Officers managed to corner and apprehend the suspect outside. It was noted that the suspect had gained access from the front gate with the intention to steal a plastic chair.

An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, the suspect was then taken to the police station for detention.

The complainant confirmed that he will follow the Police to the station to open a criminal case.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Alarm Activation**

At approximately **11:35** the alarm at a company in Christian Avenue, Epping 2 was activated. An ECID Public Safety Officer checked around the outer perimeter of the premises and found nothing suspicious

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted the armed response company. their controller confirmed that she will contact the owner of the building to deactivate the alarm and she would also dispatch their armed response team.

At approximately **11:55** the ECID Public Safety Officer reported that the alarm had been deactivated.

WEDNESDAY 28/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Possession of Suspected Stolen Goods (Arrest)**

At approximately **03:23** an ECID Public Safety Officer called for back-up opposite a garage on Viking Way, Epping 2 wrt a suspect pushing a black wheelie bin.

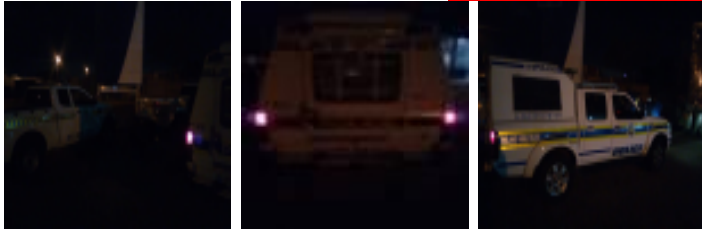
ECID Public Safety Officers responded on the scene, with the suspect's permission, the black wheelie bin was opened and suspected stolen goods were found inside. The suspect was immediately requested to cooperate which he did. An ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS and the suspect was handed over to SAPS on their arrival.

Goods found in the possession of the suspect

- 1x 12-volt car battery
- 2x amplifiers
- 1x sub speaker
- 1x car Radio

The ECID Public Safety Officer gave a statement to the police and the suspect was then taken to the Police Station for detention.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Public Disturbance

At approximately 01:28 an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from the security officer at the truck stop in Gunners Circle, Epping 1 informing him about truck drivers who were fighting. ECID Public Safety Officers responded and, on their arrival, they were informed that the drivers were fighting over three cell phones that disappeared while they were sitting together in one of truck.

An ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS who arrived at approximately 02:16.

Due to the state of drivers, the ECID Public Safety Officers were unable to get any details of the drivers. SAPS confirmed that they cannot open a case due to the fact that there is no suspect, no concrete information and the drivers were all under the influence of alcohol.

TUESDAY 05/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Theft Yard Road

At approximately **07h26** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a complaint of theft at a garage on the corner of Bofors Circle and Nourse Avenue, Epping 2 where the manager informed the officer about four pump nozzle's (value ± R36 000) that were stolen somewhere between **16:30** on the 4th January and **07:15** on the 5th January.

An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **08:49** and confirmed that they are going to open case of theft.

The ECID Public Safety Officer advised the client to consider installing the beams to assist in reducing the risk of theft or damage to the pumps.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Fire

At approximately **14:45** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted fire on the buffer between Gunners Circle and Langa railway line, opposite no. 24, Epping 1 she then despatched an ECID Public Safety Officer, the officer requested the ECID Controller to call Fire and Rescue, Fire & Rescue arrived and extinguished the fire.

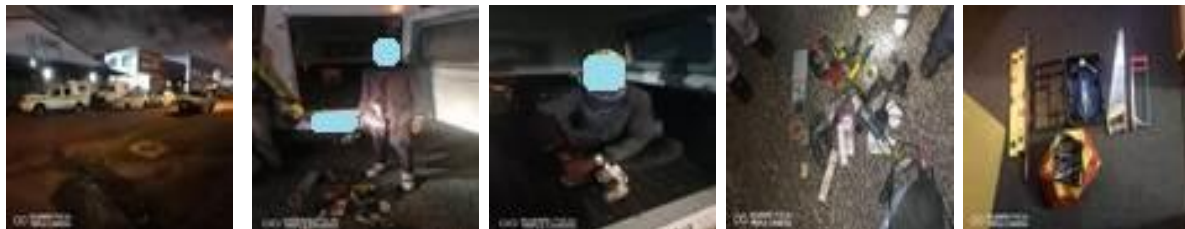


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Theft Yard Road (Arrest/Warning)

At approximately **15h08** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company in Christian Avenue, Epping 2 regarding a theft that was in progress inside another company's yard.

Four ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival three suspects were inside the premises cutting copper pipes, when they noticed the ECID Public Safety Officers they attempted to flee by jumping over the wall, the ECID Officers managed to corner and detain them on the open field. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on the scene, SAPS and the ECID CCTV Controller were unable to contact the client. SAPS confirmed that they cannot open a case or detain the suspects without the client or a complainant, the suspects were then warned and released.

TUESDAY 05/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Theft Building (Arrest)

At approximately **01:22** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company's security control room requesting assistance at Bertie Avenue, Epping 2 where it was alleged that two suspects were inside the premises.

ECID Public Safety Officers responded and on arrival the following tools were found next to the gate outside of the property; two spirit levels, one steel saw, one wood saw, one wood drill and one bag of tools, all of which were taken to the ECID office.

An ECID CCTV Controller then contacted SAPS who responded, as well as a Security Armed Response team.

After assessing the situation carefully, it was noticed that there was forced entry into the premises and the company's controller confirmed that the suspects had not exited the building.

The K9 unit and Flying Squad were called and searched the place but nothing was found and both ECID Public Safety Officers, SAPS members and armed response member departed the scene.

At approximately **03:34** the company's Controller called again notifying about a suspect that just exited the premises. ECID Public Safety Officers managed to corner and arrest one suspect on the site. The suspect was in possession of suspected stolen items; one grinder, one drill, three tape measures, twenty-six drill bits, two solo tapes and hammer. SAPS were once again contacted and they quickly responded. The suspect was then taken to the Police Station for detention and further investigation. The ECID Security Liaison Officer returned the tools to the client on 06/01/2021.

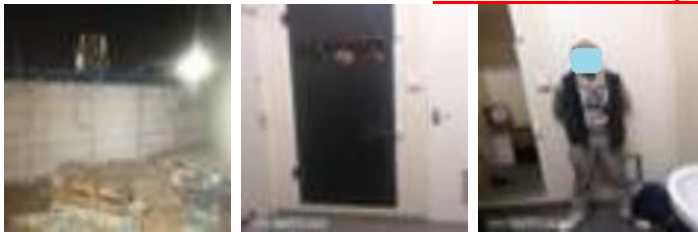
DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Armed Robbery

At approximately **23:33** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company in Bofors Circle, Epping 2 requesting ECID assistance as three suspects had broken in to the premises at approximately **21:45**, the suspects stabbed the security officer and took two cell phones, one two-way hand radio and the shops keys.

ECID Public Officers responded and found the security officer who had three stab wounds in his back and two stab wounds in his arm. The victim was then taken to hospital by his employer who confirmed that he will take the victim to the police station the following day to open a case.

SAPS arrived after the client took the victim to the hospital and they were informed that the victim went to the hospital.

WEDNESDAY 13/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Attempted Theft Yard Road (Warning)

At approximately **03:24** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a company who requested assistance wrt three suspects that were trying to steal pallets.

ECID Public Safety Officers responded, on their arrival one suspect was already detained by the company's Security Officers while other two managed to flee.

At approximately **03:46** the client arrived and confirmed that he is not interested in opening a criminal case.

The suspect was warned and banned from entering the premises.

SUNDAY 24/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Leak (Water Valve)

At approximately **11:30** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from the ECID Manger informing her about a leaking water valve on Bofors Circle, Epping 2.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched to take pictures which were then sent to the ECID Manger who reported the leak. The leak was repaired by Council the following day

WEDNESDAY 27/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Attempted Theft Building & Assault (Arrest)**

At approximately **20h14** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company in Benbow Avenue, Epping 1 wrt two suspects inside their premises stealing pallets and that they had already assaulted one of company's employees. Immediately back up was called and ECID Public Safety Officers responded together with an armed response company. On arrival one suspect managed to flee from the scene and it was alleged that he stabbed an employee. ECID Public Safety Officers assisted, one suspect was found and apprehended. The victim's wound was dressed on the scene by one of his colleagues. SAPS took the complainant's statement and the suspect was arrested and taken to SAPS for detention.

THURSDAY 21/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Street Light**

At approximately **17:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that while on patrol in Showground Avenue, Western province Park, he noticed that the street light head lamp had fallen down from one of the damaged lampposts opposite the entry gate of shopping mall due to the strong winds. The head lamp was then taken to the ECID office for safe keeping.

SUNDAY 10/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT **Workers**

At approximately **09:23** an ECID Public Safety Officer approached a construction company that was working on Bofors Circle, Epping 2. He spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that they are performing geotechnical testing for construction purposes or checking water pipes to ensure smooth operational upgrade on the pavement.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **10h36** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to an accident on Bofors Circle, Epping 2 where a pedestrian had been knocked by a vehicle. Fire and Rescue as well as the Ambulance Services arrived, the pedestrian refused to go to the hospital as he claimed that he is afraid of Covid19. The vehicle was then towed to Brakenfell.

TUESDAY 26/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **06:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer was contacted by another ECID Public Safety Officer to attend to the accident on Bofors Circle, Epping 2 involving the ECID vehicle and a motor cycle. The ECID Public Safety Officer arrived on the scene and found the ECID vehicle and the motor bike removed from the scene and parked at Bonteheuwel Station. It's was alleged by both drivers that they were driving in the direction of Moorsom Avenue, when the ECID driver was turning to the right and collided with the bike damaging the right side of the ECID vehicle. The driver of the motor bike confirmed that he would go to the Police Station later to complete an accident report. The ECID Public Safety Officer went directly to the Police Station to complete his accident report.

THURSDAY 28/01/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Business Assistance

At approximately **19:09** an ECID Public Safety Officer was contacted by another ECID Public Safety Officer to assist with traffic control due to a truck that was stuck in Bofors Circle, Epping 2 and obstructing the traffic flow. The ECID Public Safety Officers assisted by controlling the traffic and the truck was successfully removed by a tow truck.
