**SATURDAY 18/07/2020**




**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:**

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:**

**Theft in Yard**

At **20:24** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a security company's controller informing her of an alleged robbery at a truck stop. An ECID Public Safety Officer was sent to investigate

On arrival, the ECID Public Safety Officer spoke to a cleaner and the on-site security officer, who informed the ECID Public Safety Officer that two African males came in at approximately **20:10** asking if diesel was available. One of the men took out a knife and cut the wires of an FNB speed point, grabbed the speed point and both suspects ran in the direction of Cape Town Market. The ECID Public Safety Officer requested that the controller informs SAPS, SAPS arrived and took the details of the security officer and the cleaner, no case was opened.

**WEDNESDAY 22/07/2020**




**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:**

**INCIDENT DESCRIPTION:**
