DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Pothole

At approximately **10:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported a pothole on Gunners Circle in front of the Garage. An ECID CCTV Controller logged a service request with the City of Cape Town and was given a reference number.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Potholes WPP

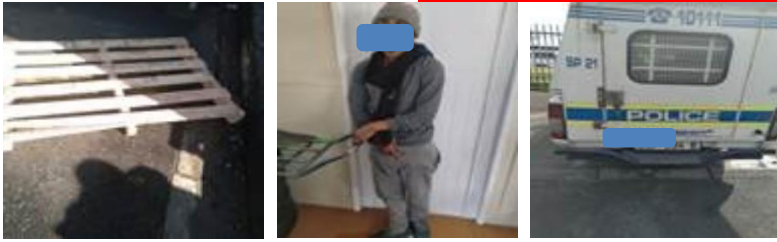


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT (CCTV)

Public Assistance

At approximately **14:19** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a truck that was stuck on the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, the truck driver confirmed that he already phoned his company and he was informed that a mechanic is on the way.

THURSDAY 22/07/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Business Assistance (Warning)

At approximately **11:50** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a complainant wrt a theft that took place from a company in Gunners Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, the complainant informed the ECID Public Safety Officer that they caught the individual stealing their property (pallets) and requested SAPS to be contacted. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **12:15**. The individual was then verbally warned by SAPS and the ECID Public Safety Officer and released.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Tree Falls on Truck

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT (CCTV)

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **15:52** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted an accident at the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Gunners Circle. An ECID Public Safety was dispatched to investigate. SAPS and an ambulance were not contacted as per the drivers' request.

TUESDAY 06/07/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft

At approximately **14:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call informing him about four individuals who were attempting to steal a drain cover in Kinghall Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers responded and they confirmed that on their arrival the alleged individuals were not found and the cover was then placed back.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **08:53** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call informing him that a pedestrian was knocked by a vehicle on Bofors Circle, an ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS (**who did not arrive**) and an Ambulance. As there were no life-threatening injuries, the patient was taken to Elsie's River Day Hospital for further medical treatment for a broken leg.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Malicious Damage to Property (Warning)

At approximately **13:23** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company requesting ECID assistance with an individual who was unruly and intentionally damaging the property. ECID Public Safety Officers responded and an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS (**who did not arrive**). The ECID Public Safety Officers warned the individual and released him, as requested by the complainant.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT (CCTV)

Suspicious Persons/Suspected Stolen Property (Warning)

At approximately **10:27** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted two individuals exiting Nourse Avenue, carrying long pieces of wood. The ECID CCTV Controller dispatched ECID Public Safety Officers who confirmed that, on their arrival, the two individuals' statements differed as to where they got the items. The suspected stolen property was confiscated and taken to the ECID office.

The two suspects were given a strong warning and released.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT (CCTV)

Suspicious Person

At approximately **17:54** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted suspicious **individuals** inside the market, ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and they found the **individual** outside of the premises. The Officers requested permission to search his bags, various food items were found. The security officer posted at the company was informed and he confirmed that they are not willing to open a case as the food items were rotten and had been discarded.

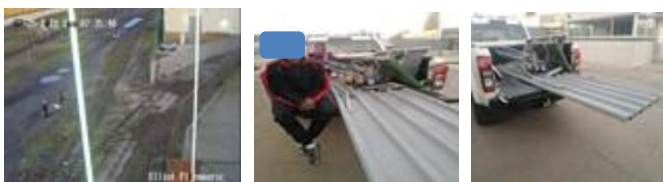


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft

At approximately **01:42** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a company in Losack Avenue who alleged that there was a break-in in progress. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, the site security officer confirmed that the suspects had already fled the scene. The owner of the company arrived later and confirmed that only the petty cash was stolen. No case was opened as the owner confirmed that he does not need to involve the police.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT (CCTV)

Theft (Arrest and Recovery of Stolen Property)

At approximately **07:35** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted two suspicious persons coming out of the Elliot/Fitzmaurice rail siding, pushing a green flat trolley that was loaded with suspicious items. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and found the suspicious persons with the suspected stolen items. The items were taken to Distell where the security on site identified the property as belonging to Distell. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS and the suspects were arrested.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft and Reckless Driving (Arrest)

At approximately **11:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed people chasing after a motor vehicle on Gunners Circle. The ECID Public Safety Officer called for backup and they managed to stop the vehicle.

Armed Robbery

At approximately **13:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer was approached by a complainant who alleged that he was robbed at gunpoint and his vehicle's keys were forcefully taken from him. The complainant informed the ECID Public Safety Officer that the suspects were driving a silver Polo. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS and a criminal case was opened.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Shooting

At approximately **11:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant reporting a shooting incident that took place on the corner of Gunners Circle and Fisher Avenue on Sunday 18/07/2021 at approximately **23:00**.

The complainant alleged that gunshots were fired at their staff transport vehicle. The ECID Liaison Officer and an ECID Public Safety Officer were dispatched to investigate.
