DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Missing Drain Cover

At approximately **11:45** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Fitzmaurice Avenue, he noticed an open drain which he reported to the ECID CCTV Controller who in turn contacted the City of Cape Town and received a reference number.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Faulty Traffic Lights

At approximately **13:15** the ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from the ECID Manager enquiring if the traffic lights at the intersection of Viking Way and Showground Avenue had been reported as they were faulty.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched to check and he confirmed that the traffic lights were faulty as they were not going green for vehicles leaving Showground Avenue, which forced these road users to drive through the red traffic lights. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted the CoCT, logged a complaint and received a reference number.

Street Light-Fire

At approximately **21:34** the ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call requesting the CoCT's emergency services number as a street light had caught fire in Hewett Avenue.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched to the scene, Fire and Rescue and the CofCT were contacted, the fire was successfully extinguished.

Damage to Property-Warning-WPP

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **06:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to an accident at the intersection of Jakes Gerwel and Bofors Circle.

It was alleged by both drivers that they were driving towards Langa when the Hyundai that was driving from Goodwood side collided with the Avanza that was driving from Gunnars Circle. The Avanza drove in front of the Hyundai who had the right of way, the matter was processed by Traffic Officials.

Business Assistance

At approximately **09:40** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a company in Fisher Avenue requesting ECID assistance with an employee who was having a seizure. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched while the ECID CCTV Controller contacted an Ambulance, the employee was treated on the scene by the medics and then taken to hospital.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Suspicious Vehicle

At approximately **02:50** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling on Bofors Circle, he noticed a suspicious vehicle and he called for a backup. The ECID Public Safety officers responded and approached the vehicle cautiously and found the vehicle to be empty. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on site.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Drunk Driving

At approximately **03:56** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was out on patrol, when he noticed an individual lying on the ground near Viking Way. The ECID Public Safety Officer confirmed that the individual seemed to have lost control of his motor bike, the ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS and the Ambulance. At approximately **04:10** Fire and Rescue arrived and they confirmed that the individual had not sustained any injuries. At approximately **04:18** the Ambulance arrived however he refused to get medical help. At approximately **04:32** SAPS arrived and took the individual as well as his motor bike to Elsie's River Police Station as it was alleged that he was under the influence of alcohol.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft Yard-Warning

At approximately **02:57** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Gerry Ferry Crescent, he was notified by an unknown individual about a suspect who was busy stealing from a company in Gunners Circle. The ECID Public Safety Officers responded and caught the suspect when he jumped over the wall, he had five boxes of glucose biscuits in his possession. The ECID Public Safety Officer contacted the client who was not willing to press charges against the suspect as the stolen biscuits had expired in 2018. The ECID was requested to warn and release the suspect.

Attempted Theft Yard

At approximately **12:23** while the ECID Public Safety officers were patrolling at the railway tracks, they noticed damaged electrical cables on the ground. MONDAY 01/03/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Stop and Search-Confiscation

At approximately **03:50** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Kinghall Avenue, he noticed two individuals pulling a flat trolley with a large bag on it. The ECID Public Safety Officer then called for backup and the Officers requested permission to search the suspects, which they agreed too. Two air conditioners were found in the bag and the suspects confirmed that they picked them up on the railway tracks. Since the lawful owner was unknown to the ECID Public Safety Officers, the items were confiscated and taken to the ECID Office.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Armed Robbery

At approximately **08:45** the ECID CCTV Controller received a call requesting ECID assistance regarding an employee who had been robbed at gun point. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and met with the complaint who informed him that while she was on her way to work on the corner of Bofors Circle and Nourse Avenue she was approached by a suspect who was in possession of a 9mm pistol, the suspect robbed her of her cell phone. The victim was advised to go to the police station and open a case

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Murder

At approximately **06:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer was contacted to assist with a patient at the gate of a company on Gunners Circle. On arrival, the ECID Public Safety Officer spoke with the patient and her boyfriend who both alleged that they were walking from Bonteheuvel to Epping 1 when they were chased by a suspect near Langa Bridge on the Epping 1 side. They alleged that the suspect was in the possession of a firearm and fired three shots, one shot struck the patient on the left side of her face, just near the ear and they ran to a company on Gunners for assistance. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, Fire and Rescue, as well as an Ambulance. The reason for the attack is unknown, it was confirmed that the bullet did not go in/through, it only grazed the patient and she was taken to hospital.
