Public Assistance

Public Assistance

At approximately **10:18** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that while patrolling in Gunners Circle, he came across with a group of cyclists in Jellicoe Avenue.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Public Assistance

It was alleged by the deceased's girlfriend that the deceased had a stomach problem and had been to the hospital on Wednesday 21/10/2020 and was given 2 tables to drink, one before he went to sleep and one in the morning when he wakes up. This morning at approximately **07:00** when she tried to wake her boyfriend up, she noticed that he was not breathing.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted the Ambulance Services as well as SAPS regarding the matter.

A Police Sergeant from SAPS arrived to open an inquest docket.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Public Assistance

At approximately **20:10** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a vehicle that was stuck on Bofors Circle opposite Bonteheuwel Station and spoke with the gentleman who confirmed that the vehicle's right back wheel bearing came off while he was driving. The Public Safety Officer assisted by putting out orange cones on the road to warn other motorists to be cautious.

Motor Vehicle and Motor Bike Accident

At approximately **16:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to an accident between a motor vehicle and a motor bike in Gunners Circle. The ECID CCTV Controller was requested to contact SAPS, Ambulance and Fire & Rescue. The ambulance and Metro Police arrived and the driver of the bike was declared dead at the scene. The deceased was taken to Cape Town State Mortuary.




DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Suspicious Vehicle

Suspicious Persons

At approximately 10:13 an ECID CCTV Controller spotted two males pushing a wheely bin on the rail tracks, going in the direction of Bofors Circle and despatched an ECID Public Safety Officer who met with the suspects who told him that they have been sent by their supervisor to sell the scrap at SA Metal. The Public Safety Officer spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that he did send the suspects to sell the old scrap.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Suspicious Persons and Animal Assistance

At approximately **14:15** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted four males running from a company in Bofors Circle towards Goodenough Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer responded and contacted other ECID Public Safety Officers for backup.

On Arrival the ECID Public Safety Officer spoke with one of the gentlemen who was with a horse and he confirmed that his horse ran away on Valhalla Drive after the cart unattached itself from the horse and they had to chase after the horse.

While the ECID Public Safety Officer was examining the horse, the inspector arrived and confirmed that he is aware of the incident and the horse will be taken for treatment.

Possession of Suspected Stolen Property

At approximately **19:41** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a complaint about three suspects walking up the Gerry Ferry siding carrying heavy equipment. An ECID Public Safety Officer responded together with the quad bike drivers and found the suspects whom were in position of one pallet jack and a large piece of metal, the third suspect fled the scene. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS. Furthermore, the two remaining suspects were arrested by SAPS.

Theft and Confiscation

At approximately **02:33** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a security officer informing him about a suspect that had jumped into a premises in Packer Avenue, stole two drums and ran to the rail tracks. All ECID Public Safety Officers responded and caught the suspect on the rail tracks carrying the drums. The drums were confiscated and handed back to the complainant.
