**WEDNESDAY 04/11/2020**



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Public Assistance**

At approximately **14h10** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended an assault at the informal market where assistance was requested by a lady that was assaulted by her boyfriend and needed medical attention

The ECID CCTV Operator contacted the Ambulance Services who were busy and would only be available after 15h00.

The ECID CCTV Operator then contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that they will send a team.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **MVA Involving a Pedestrian**

At approximately **15h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended an accident on Gunners Circle opposite Sonnendal where a 13-year-old boy was knocked by a motor vehicle.

The ECID CCTV Operator contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that they will send a team.

The ECID CCTV controller also contacted SAPS who confirmed that they will send their vehicle.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Possession of Suspected stolen property**

At approximately **11h31** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted a police convoy on Bofors Circle where there was a horse cart loaded with big gates, the Controller despatched a Public Safety Officer who confirmed that he spoke with a Constable who informed him that they arrested 1 suspect for being in possession of suspected stolen property, SAPS took the confiscated gates with them for further investigation.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **MVA Involving a Pedestrian**

At approximately **12h29** the ECID CCTV Operator spotted an accident on Jake's Gerwel Drive on Langa Bridge and dispatched a Public Safety Officer. The Public Safety Officer confirmed that a pedestrian was hit by a taxi, the ECID officer placed traffic cones around the scene to assist with traffic control. The CCTV Operator contacted the Ambulance who confirmed that they will dispatch a team, another Public Safety Officer contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that they will also despatch a team. Fire and Rescue arrived and assessed the patient, it was confirmed that the pedestrian had sustained serious injuries. The taxi driver offered to take the patient to Bonteheuwel Hospital, the Fire and Rescue officer noted that it was safe to do. The patient was then transported to the hospital.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Suspicious Persons**

At approximately at **13h50** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that while patrolling in Gunners Circle, opposite Kingsley, he noticed two suspects pulling horse cart loaded with the shell of a Chrysler Neon. An additional Public Safety Officer responded in order to investigate further

The two gentlemen presented a letter they got from the owner of the vehicle that simply stated his contact information and residential address.

The ECID CCTV Operator contacted the owner of the car who had provided the letter, he confirmed that he had indeed given them permission to take the car shell from his garage.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Malicious Damage to Property**

Approximately at **19h32** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that there were boys throwing stones at cars on Bofors Circle as they were passing Losack Avenue. The ECID night shift Public Safety Officers responded and warned motorists to be cautious. The ECID CCTV Operator contacted Elsie's River SAPS but SAPS did not arrive. SAPS and Law Enforcement are doing extra patrols.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Pointing of Fire Arm**

At approximately **14h15** the ECID's Public Safety Officer's responded to a complaint at the Engen Garage (Kempston Truck Stop) on Gunners Circle where there was a complaint of a truck driver allegedly pointing of firearm at a bus driver.

On arrival, the suspect was not on the scene, the ECID CCTV Operator contacted SAPS regarding the matter as the complainant confirmed that he is willing to open a criminal case. A criminal case of pointing of firearm was opened.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Animal Assistance**

At approximately **15h00** ECID Public Safety Officer's attended to a complaint of a horse that was allegedly pulling a heavy load. On arrival, at SA Metal in Bofors Circle the load was already off loaded and the horse was outside. Ma'am Lizette was contacted and she contacted a Cart Horse Inspector to come and check the horse. The Inspector arrived and confirmed that the horse is not in good condition and that the owner will have to take it to Cart Horse so that it can be given medication and hay so that it can gain weight.

#### **Fire**

At approximately **11h43** the ECID CCTV Operator spotted a fire on the open field opposite Moorsom Avenue, the operator contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that they will despatch their fire truck

The Fire and Rescue team arrived and successfully extinguished the fire.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Attempted Smash and Grab**

At approximately **11h49** the ECID CCTV Operator spotted 2 suspects who are suspected of being involved in smash and grabs on Jakes Gerwel Drive on the Langa Bridge.

The ECID Public Safety Officer responded and the 2 suspects walked back to Langa, due to the quick response of the Officer, a smash and grab was prevented.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Electrical Contractors on Site**

At approximately **14h12** the ECID CCTV Operator spotted construction vehicles next to the Jakes Gerwel Traffic Lights, she then despatched the ECID Public Safety Officer. The Officer confirmed that he spoke with the supervisor, who informed him that they are changing fibre cables.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Attempted Theft Building**

At approximately **23h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from ERC Security's control room requesting ECID assistance. It was alleged that there were four armed suspects attempting to break-in at the Lunch Box situated on the corner of Bofors Circle & Goodenough Avenue.

The security officer posted at Stalcor alleged that while he was patrolling around the premises, he noticed the four suspects trying to break into at the shop. When the suspects saw him they threatened him with firearm and demanded he hand over the keys of the premises.

The security officer managed to escape and notified his controller, the ECID night shift Public Safety Officers cautiously responded.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted Elsie's SAPS, two vehicles responded but suspects were already gone, SAPS promise to do regularly patrols in the area.

**Land Invasion Prevention Operation**

At approximately **17h07** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted Law Enforcement vehicles on the open field opposite Evans Avenue conducting a special operation in order to prevent land invasion.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Carjacking (Truck)**

At approximately **20h17** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a complaint at OK Furniture in Gunners Circle, where the manager requested assistance from the ECID as two of his trucks were hijacked, one was later recovered by SAPS. He alleged that this incident occurred between **10h30** and **11h00** near the traffic lights opposite SBH at Jakes Gerwel Drive.

**Suspicious Vehicle**

At approximately **12h59** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted a vehicle on Bofors Circle opposite Jumbo who appeared to have broken down, the Controller despatched an ECID Public Safety Officer who confirmed that the vehicle had a problem with its ball joint.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Possession of Stolen Property**

At approximately **03h23** an ECID Public Safety Officer received an anonymous call reporting that there are three suspects stealing pallets from one of the businesses inside Cape Town Market. ECID Public Safety Officer's responded and found the three suspects in Gerry Ferry Crescent next to Jive, they were in possession of 6 wooden pallets. The ECID Public Safety Officers conducted an investigation and it was established that the pallets were stolen from the Pallet Bank inside Cape Town Market. The security guard on duty at Cape Town Market confirmed that he does not want to open a criminal case. The ECID Public Safety Officers gave the suspects a stern warning and the pallets were handed to the site security officer.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Fire**

At approximately **18h27** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted fire on the field opposite Bonteheuwel Train Station.

The CCTV Operator contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that they will despatch their Fire Truck, Fire and Rescue extinguished the fire.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Murder**

At approximately **06h55** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a murder incident where a female was shot dead, the officer spoke with the manager from Byers Security who informed the ECID Public Safety Officer that it was alleged that the lady was standing next to the gate at number 11 Kinghall Avenue busy with her cell phone, while waiting for an Uber when the suspect came to her, pointed a firearm at her demanding the phone. The lady then handed the phone to the suspect and she ran back into the property, the suspect then fired one fatal shot, hitting the lady in the back. Ambulance services arrived on the scene and the lady was declared dead at the scene, a murder docket was opened and the deceased was taken to the Cape Town State Mortuary. An ECID Public Safety Officer assisted with gathering video footage which led to the identification and arrest of the suspect.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Fire**

At approximately **19h12** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from ERC Security's control room requesting ECID assistance at no.12 Elliott Avenue where they alleged there is fire in the building.

On arrival, the ECID Public Safety Officers found out that the substation outside the property was on fire.

The ECID CCTV controller contacted Fire and Rescue who confirmed that their fire truck will attend.

The ECID Public Safety Officer used the vehicle's fire extinguisher to prevent the fire from spreading, Fire and Rescue arrived and extinguished the fire.


#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Theft of a Motor Vehicle**

At approximately **10h55** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a complaint of theft of a motor vehicle that took place on Gunners Circle opposite Bounty Brands. The officer spoke with the complainant who confirmed that at approximately **10h20**, when he was exiting Bounty Brands, he saw his vehicle drive past him, driven by an unknown male. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who requested the contact number of the vehicles owner so that they can phone the complainant.

The ECID CCTV Controller did a video play back and the vehicle was spotted, it left Gunners Circle at **10h32** in the direction of the Jakes Gerwel traffic lights. A case was not opened due to the fact that the owner had bought the vehicle without any documents.

##### **Fire**

### **Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **17h35** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended a motor vehicle accident on Jakes Gerwel Drive at the traffic light, the ECID CCTV Controller contacted Pinelands SAPS and Ambulance Services. The injured individual was taken to Melomed Hospital.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Theft Building**

At approximately **01h20** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from ERC Security's control room informing him about a burglary in progress at no.12 Elliot Avenue at Jive's store rooms.

ECID Public Safety Officer's responded and found the security officer on site who confirmed there is nothing going on there. It was alleged that the site security officer who is working for Jive had broken into the store room and called someone from the location to steal cooldrinks at Jive. The client was called to the scene and 2 Suspects were found in the building busy packing the client's cooldrinks into a white Polo Vivo.

The value of the items they attempted to steal is R 15,160 which consisted of 2 x pallets of Reboot energy drinks and one pallet of 2lt mango cooldrinks. The ECID CCTV Operator contacted Elsie's SAPS who arrived immediately after the call.

The security officer and the 2 x suspects were arrested and taken to Elsie's Police Station and the suspects' vehicle was impounded.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Smash and Grab**

At **11h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer was approached by a member of the public requesting ECID assistance, the complainant was a victim of a smash and grab on Jake's Gerwel Drive on the Langa side of the bridge. The complainant confirmed that his vehicle's passenger front window was smashed and his wife's hand bag containing R 2 800.00 was stolen.

The ECID CCTV Controller contacted Pinelands SAPS who confirmed that the victim should lay a criminal charge at Langa Police Station giving a full description of the suspect, the complainant went to lay a criminal charge.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Theft of Motor Vehicle**

At approximately **12h00** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a gentleman from Cape Mail who requested the ECID check the CCTV camera footage as his motor vehicle was stolen on Friday 06/11/2020 between **08h00** and **16H15** at the Cape Mail parking area.

The ECID CCTV Operator and Assistant CCTV Operator reviewed the footage and noticed that the vehicle left Mail Street at approximately **10h00**, joined Showground Avenue then turned into Viking Way and then on to Jake's Gerwel Drive heading straight toward Langa.
