

### **SATURDAY 01/05/2021**



#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Workers**

At approximately **12:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that the City of Cape Town Water and Sanitation were working on the corner of Gunners Circle and Grenville Avenue. He spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that they are busy investigating the cause of the irregular road.

### **SUNDAY 02/05/2021**



#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Fire**

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Insecure Premises**

At approximately **18:15** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling in Mail Street, he noticed a gate that was left open. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fidelity ADT Control Room requesting they inform their client.

**TUESDAY 04/05/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **18:41** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported an accident at the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Gunners Circle where 2 x vehicles were involved. The scene was handled by a Traffic Official and the patient will be taken to Groote Schuur Hospital. The client was later assisted with the video footage as per his request.

**FRIDAY 28/05/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Public assistance**

At approximately **15:40** while an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling on Gunners Circle where he noticed a 76-year-old member of the public lying down in front of 76 Gunners Circle, it was alleged that someone had struck him with a stone. His hip was injured and he could not move his leg. The ECID Security Liaison Officer took the patient with his private vehicle to Vanguard day hospital, since the ambulance that was contacted did not arrive.

**SUNDAY 23/05/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Damage to CID Property**

At approximately **00:50** while on patrol-an ECID Public Safety Officer heard strange sounds from the rear left wheel. The ECID Public Safety Officer stopped the ECID vehicle immediately to investigate. He found a part of a truck trailer strap stuck in the rear left tyre and also noticed that the mud guard as well as a part of the vehicle body were damaged.

**TUESDAY 25/05/2021**

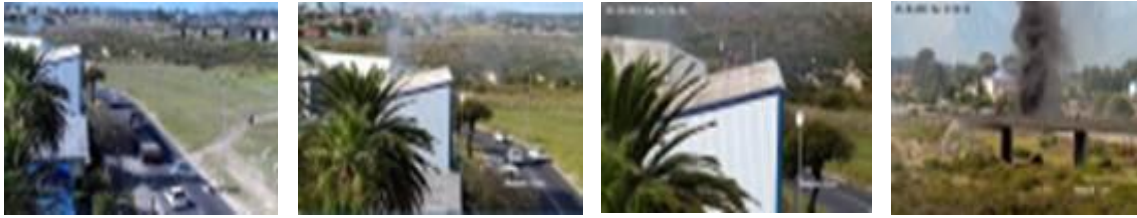


**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

## THURSDAY 20/05/2021

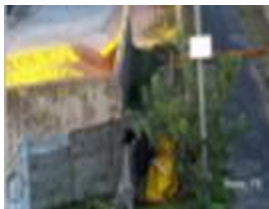


### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**TUESDAY 25/05/2021**

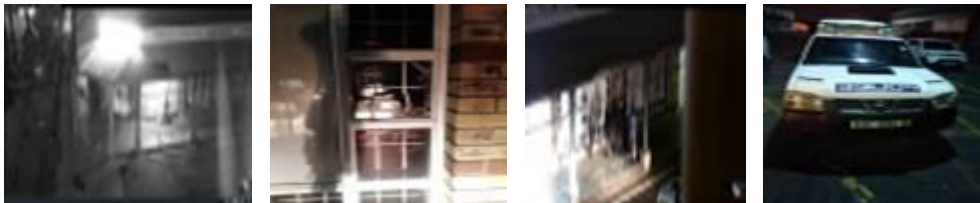


**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft-Yard (Arrest)**

At approximately **02:27** an ECID Public Safety Officer was patrolling on the rails behind Cape Town Market when he noticed 3 suspects who were digging for cables and he called for back-up, the ECID Public Safety Officers managed to apprehended 2 suspects. SAPS was contacted as well as the Ambulance to attend to the one female suspect that had injured herself while trying to run away. 1 suspect was taken by SAPS and the injured suspect was taken to the hospital.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft-Building (Arrest)**
