

# **CCTV INCIDENT REPORT-OCTOBER 2021**

**FRIDAY 01/10/2021**



## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Workers in Epping**

At approximately **13:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a construction company working at the informal market building a concrete vibracrete wall. An ECID Public Safety Officer spoke to the supervisor who confirmed that they are enclosing the area around the informal traders.

## **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

### **Dumping-Warning**

At approximately **15:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from the ECID Manager reporting dumping in progress on Gunners Circle opposite Cape Town Market. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched on their way they came across the truck which they escorted back to the scene to remove the rubble. The driver of the truck was given a stern warning.

### **Leakage-Water Valve**

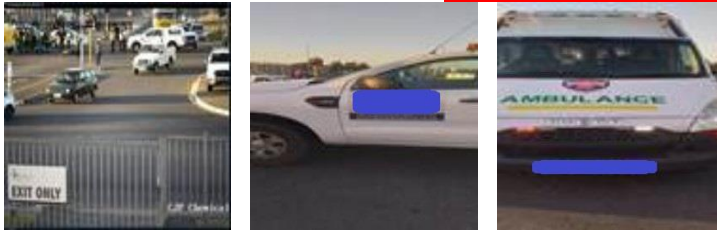


**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Motor Vehicle Accident**

At approximately **06:25** An ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an accident at the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Bofors Circle involving a bus, a motor vehicle and a truck. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, Fire and Rescue as well as an Ambulance. The patients were taken to hospital and one of the vehicles was towed away.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Motor Bike**

At approximately **18:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an accident at the intersection of Viking Way and Showground Avenue, an ECID CCTV Controller contacted the Ambulance Services, SAPS and Traffic. At approximately **18:27** the Emergency Services arrived on the scene. SAPS did not arrive on the scene; the scene was processed by the Traffic Officer. The injured motor bike driver was taken to hospital.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Hit and Run**

At approximately **14:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by a taxi driver informing him about a hit and run that took place in Bofors Circle. The truck that hit the pedestrian was pointed out to the ECID Public Safety Officer. The ECID Public Safety Officer caught up with the truck and the driver was requested to go back to the scene. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue as well as the Ambulance Services, while an ECID CCTV Assistant contacted SAPS. The patient was taken to hospital and a case was opened.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Operation-Law Enforcement-Homeless People**

At approximately **19:23** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed Law Enforcement Officers in Gerry Ferry Crescent. He spoke to the supervisor who informed him that they came to remove the homeless people. The homeless people were successfully removed.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Burning of Wire**

At approximately **10:31** an ECID CCTV Assistant spotted 2 x individuals making a fire between the rails at the Bertie/Bofors siding gate. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and on their arrival they found the individuals burning electric wires. The individuals were instructed to extinguish the fire, which they did. They were warned and escorted out of the area.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Suspicious Persons-Warning**

At approximately **23:43** an ECID CCTV Assistant spotted 3 x suspicious persons trying to jump into a business premises. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched. The 3 x individuals were found, the items found in their possession were confiscated. The suspects were escorted out of the area and given a stern warning.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Suspicious Vehicle**

At approximately **14:42** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a white motor vehicle stuck near the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, the driver confirmed that the vehicle has a problem with the CV joints and he was waiting on a relative to assist with the towing of his vehicle.

**Public Assistance**

At approximately **10:56** an ECID Public Safety Officer receive a phone call from a complainant who requested assistance with her missing sister who was last seen at a shop in Edgemean, where after she would have gone straight to a shop in Epping to buy some snacks. The ECID Public Safety Officer confirmed that they will be on the lookout for her sister and advised the complainant to go to the Police Station to open a missing person file.

**Squatter**

At approximately **08:10** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an erected structure on the buffer between Viking Way and Bofors Circle. The ECID Public Safety Officer called for back-up. The owner of the structure was not found and the structure was destroyed.

ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and a suspect was apprehended. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on the scene and the suspect was arrested.

The protesters continued with their march to different companies and left the area at approximately **14:30**.

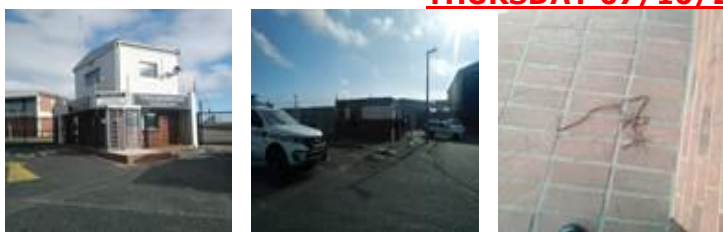


**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Damage to Private Property**

At approximately **13:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant informing him about a broken window. **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft-Yard-Warning**

At approximately **16:18** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from the ECID Manager reporting that the security officers posted at one of the business premises in Bertie Avenue were requesting assistance. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, on arrival the security officer pointed out the individual whom allegedly had tried to steal some old scrap metal. The individual was warned and escorted out of the area.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Attempted Theft-Building-Arrest**

At approximately **12:00** An ECID Public Safety Officer received a tipoff from an informant about 2 x suspicious persons hiding inside a business premises. ECID Public Safety officers were despatched and on arrival they closed all possible exits, 1 x suspect managed to escape and the other suspect was trapped by a fence. The suspect was apprehended and handed to the Police who arrived at **14:21**.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Road**

At approximately **18:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from an informant reporting 2 x individuals stealing cable in Viking Way opposite a business premises' gate. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, the individuals were not found. The cable was confiscated and taken to the ECID office.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Road-WPP**

At approximately **20:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a stationary truck in Showground Avenue next to the sports field. The ECID Public Safety Officer spoke to the driver who informed him that the truck's batteries were stolen. The driver of the truck had already informed his company, new batteries were installed and the truck left the area.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Building**

At approximately **01:27** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a tipoff from an informer about 6 x individuals who were pulling something heavy on a flat trolley proceeding from Gerry Ferry Crescent towards the back of the informal market. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and on their arrival no individuals were found. The ECID Public Safety Officer noticed that 2 x refrigerator motors were stolen from one of the business premises in the centre. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS as well as the client who arrived and a case was opened.

**WEDNESDAY 20/12/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft Building**

At approximately **12:36** an ECID CCTV Controller received a call from a complainant reporting a theft that took place at one of the shops in Gunners Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched while an ECID CCTV Assistant contacted the Police. The complainant explained how the incident took place. SAPS arrived at **13:37** but was unable to open a case due to the fact that the complainant had left the scene.

**SATURDAY 02/10/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Armed Robbery-Firearm**

At approximately **15:01** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by 1 x individual who alleged that 3 x unknown individuals robbed a shop in Wembley Centre. The ECID Public Safety Officer called for back-up, SAPS also responded. The suspects had already fled in the direction of the market. The complainant was advertised to open a criminal case.

**FRIDAY 29/10/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Armed Robbery and Kidnapping**

At approximately **11:20** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by the complainant in Gerry Ferry Crescent who informed him about an armed robbery and kidnapping that took place at one of the shops. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS. The ECID Public Safety Officer spoke with 2 x complainants who alleged that at approximately **11:15** they were with the owner of another shop when 5 x individuals pretending to be customers, came into the shop asking about prices. Both complainants further alleged that on the arrival of their employer, 2 of the 5 individuals took out firearms and instructed them to hand over all their phones as well as an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspects pushed both the employers into the employers vehicle and drove off. SAPS arrived at **11:33** and a case was opened.

**SUNDAY 30/10/2021**



**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Dead Body Recovered**

At approximately **11:54** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed 2 x Police bakkies with 5 x African females crossing the buffer opposite Evans Avenue in the direction of the railway lines. The ECID Public Safety Officer followed them and was informed about a body of a small baby that was dumped on the field. An ambulance arrived at approximately **05:00**, Forensic Pathology Services arrived at approximately **05:28**, the body was taken to the Salt River Mortuary.
