MONDAY 07/09/2020



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident-BP Garage (Bofors Circle)

Public Safety Officers were despatched and, on their arrival, they found a female lying down in the road in front of the informal market, she was declared dead. It was alleged by an anonymous eyewitness that it was hit and run incident by a driver of a white car.

The vehicle that was alleged to have hit the deceased was found unattended at the traffic lights opposite M&R Marketing.

The deceased was taken away to Salt River State Mortuary and the vehicle was towed to Stikland.
