

WEDNESDAY 08/09/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Dead Body Recovered

At approximately **04:58** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a security company that alleged that there was an unknown individual who committed suicide on the buffer between Gunners Circle and Jan Smuts bridge. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, on arrival they confirmed that the individual hung himself on one of the trees. At approximately **05:22** an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **05:35**. An ECID CCTV Assistant contacted an ambulance at approximately **05:30**, the ambulance arrived at approximately **08:38**, the individual was declared dead. At approximately **09:45** the state pathology arrived on the scene to take the body to the mortuary.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Armed Robbery

At approximately **12:33** an ECID Public Safety Officer received an alert from an informer informing him that an armed robbery was in progress at a shop in Gunners Circle. Back up was immediately called while an ECID CCTV Controller was contacting SAPS. SAPS arrived on the scene and a case was opened, no injuries were reported.

THURSDAY 23/09/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Mugging/Robbery

At approximately **06:44** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by a complainant who alleged that he was robbed by 2 x unknown individuals on the buffer between Bofors Circle and Valhalla Drive Bridge. An ECID Public Safety Officer noticed 2 x suspicious persons running across Valhalla Drive. The complainant was advised to go to the Police Station to open a case.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Stolen Goods Recovered

At approximately **02:50** an ECID CCTV Assistant spotted 2 x individuals stealing empty pallets from a company on the corner of Bofors Circle and Moorsom Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched, on their arrival the suspects fled the scene leaving about 10 x pallets lying on the buffer between Bofors Circle and the Bonteheuwel railway line. The pallets were taken back to the company and handed to the security on site.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Theft Building-Arrest

At approximately **08:23** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from an informer wrt a suspect who committed a break-in at one of the business premises in Packer Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and the suspect was apprehended. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on the scene and the suspect was arrested.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft Building

At approximately **00:33** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted 2 x suspicious persons who were trying to break in at a company in Bofors Circle. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and the suspects ran away towards Bonteheuwel. An ECID Public Safety Officer spoke with the security on site who confirmed that nothing was stolen.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Malicious Damage to Property

At approximately **07:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant who informed him that on arrival at their business premises they noticed a window that had been struck and damaged by a bullet. The bullet was found in one of their offices. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, on arrival the ECID Public Safety Officer was shown the bullet as well as the damage. At approximately **08:00** an ECID CCTV Assistant contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **09:30** and a case was opened.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Suspicious Person-Searched

At approximately **07:08** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a suspicious individual in Bofors Circle walking toward Nourse Avenue, the individual was pulling a big white bath containing a big white heavy-duty bag. ECID Public Safety Officers were despatched and on arrival the individual was asked if the bath and bag may be searched. The individual gave permission but nothing suspicious was found in his possession.

Confiscation of Black Wheelie Bin

At approximately **11:08** an ECID CCTV Assistant spotted an individual pushing a black bin in Gunners Circle passing Langa Station. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, nothing suspicious was found inside the black wheelie bin, the bin was confiscated and taken to the ECID office.

Confiscation of Trolley

An ECID Public Safety Officer cautiously approach the individuals and found nothing suspicious in their possession. The trolley was confiscated.

SAPS ASSISTANCE

At approximately **08:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed 3 x SAPS vehicles chasing a white 1toner Hyundai bakkie in Bofors Circle. The vehicle was forcefully stopped and SAPS ordered the driver and passenger to exit the vehicle. The vehicle was cautiously searched with help of the ECID Public Safety Officers, no suspicious items were found and the vehicle was released.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **15:33** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an accident on Bofors Circle involving 2 x motor vehicles. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, Traffic and an Ambulance. SAPS did not arrive on the scene. The paramedics tended to the wound to the face of the driver of the one vehicle.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **07:20** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a member of public who informed him about an accident on the corner of Bofors Circle and Bertie Avenue where a pedestrian was hit by a motor vehicle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched. At approximately **07:21** an ECID CCTV Assistant contacted an ambulance and SAPS. At approximately **07:23** an ECID CCTV Assistant contacted Fire and Rescue, they arrived at approximately **07:36**. The pedestrian sustained injuries to his right leg and since the ambulance was delayed, the pedestrian was taken to hospital by the driver of the motor vehicle who hit him. SAPS never arrived on the scene.

WEDNESDAY 29/09/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **05:55** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a fire in Viking Way at the informal settlement and immediately dispatched an ECID Public Safety Officer while the ECID CCTV Assistant contacted Fire and Rescue. Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene and managed to extinguish the fire. It was confirmed that +/- 10 shacks were affected by the fire. No injuries or deaths were reported.

WEDNESDAY 08/09/2021



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Public Assistance

At approximately **20:57** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a stationary truck in Bofors Circle. The driver confirmed that he was turning on the bend when the truck lost its load. ECID Public Safety Officers then assisted the driver by controlling the traffic and reloading the truck.
