



## CCTV REPORT-DECEMBER 2021

**WEDNESDAY 29/12/2021**



### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Dead Body Recovered**

At approximately **07:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by an individual who informed him about a deceased person near Langa Station.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, on his arrival he found a naked deceased body with open wounds on both legs and face. The ECID Public Safety Officer cordoned off the scene, at approximately **07:45** the ECID CCTV Assistant contacted SAPS and the EMS. At approximately **08:19** SAPS arrived on the scene, EMS arrived at approximately **10:13** and the body was certified and declared dead. At approximately **10:55** the SAPS photographer arrived and took photos of the scene. At approximately **12:23** the forensic pathologist arrived, an inquest docket was opened and the body was then taken to the state mortuary.

### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Workers in Area**

At approximately **14:06** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted contract workers cleaning the rail sidings between Cochrane and Evans Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and spoke with the supervisor who confirmed that they came to clean the rail sidings.

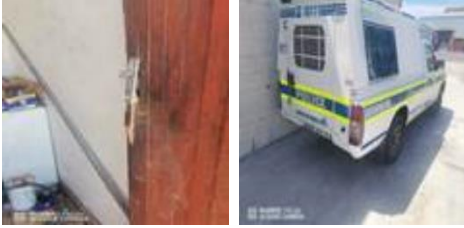


### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

#### **Trolley Confiscated**

At approximately **11:30** ECID Public Safety Officers spotted a suspicious person pushing a trolley next to the informal market. The suspicious person was approached and the trolley was confiscated.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Armed Robbery-Yard**

At approximately **11:03** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported that while patrolling in Cable Close, he was alerted by a security guard about a robbery. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched to provide assistance. The security guard reported a robbery by 3 male suspects of which one was in possession of a firearm, no shots were fired and no one was injured. The security guard could not give a description of the suspects as he was still in shock. SAPS opened a docket for further investigation.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Yard**

At approximately **12:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant in Grenville Avenue, reporting a break-in that took place the previous day. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, he spoke to the complainant who confirmed that the suspects gained access to the property from the railway line side and stole steel pipes and cable wires. SAPS were already on the scene.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

**Theft-Building-Arrest**

At approximately **22:05** on Saturday 25 December ECID Public Safety Officers were flagged down by a security officer who informed them about suspects that broke in and stole some property. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and pursued the 3 suspects. 1 suspect were apprehended and handed over to the security officials at the company. At approximately **22:11** the ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived at approximately **22:27**. The security officers from the company gave their statement to SAPS, the suspect was taken to the Police Station for questioning and a case file was opened.

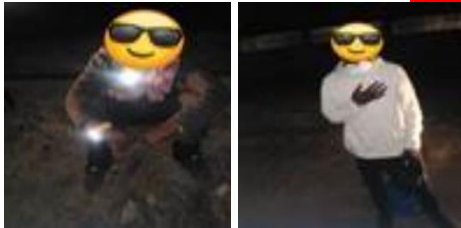
#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Attempted Armed Theft-Yard**

At approximately **03:03** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted 3 suspects entering into company's premises on the corner of Bofors Circle and Nourse Avenue. At **03:17** ECID Public Safety Officers approached the premises, the perpetrators came rushing out with weapons and fled in the direction of Bonteheuwel. The security officer on duty confirmed that the perpetrators had already opened a truck attempting to take goods from inside but because of the ECID's control room and Public Safety Officers' fast reaction time, the suspects were distracted and the theft was prevented, the perpetrators got away with his cell phone and bag.

No injuries were reported and no gun shots were fired. The owner was informed by the security service and no Police was informed.

### WEDNESDAY 29/12/2021



#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Suspicious Persons-Searched-Warning**

At approximately **22:28** An ECID Public Safety Officer noticed 3 suspicious individuals trying to jump into a company's property. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival the 3 suspicious individuals were spotted but 1 managed to escape. The other 2 suspicious individuals were searched after they gave permission, nothing suspicious was found in their possession. The individuals were released with stern warning and escorted out of the area.

### THURSDAY 16/12/2021



#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**

##### **Stolen Goods Recovered-Warning**

At approximately **02:16** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by a member of public in Bofors Circle, claiming he has been robbed of his smartphone by an unknown male who then ran away in the direction of the Fire Station.

ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and surrounded the area. The alleged suspect was spotted and caught, the alleged suspect was searched and a screw driver and the smartphone were found in his possession. The complainant did not want to open a case since he got his phone back. The suspect was escorted out of the area with stern warning and the screw driver was confiscated.

**Damage to Private Property**

At approximately **09:22** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed broken slabs at the back of informal market in Viking Way. The ECID Public Safety Liaison Officer contacted one of the managers at CTM who confirmed that they were aware of the damage and they will attend to the matter.

**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT CCTV Controller**

**Possession of Suspected Stolen Property-Confiscation**

At approximately **13:51** the ECID CCTV Controller spotted 1 suspicious individual in the Bofors / Hewett rail siding. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on arrival of ECID Public Safety Officers, the individual alleged that she was looking for the scrap. ECID Public Safety Officers then checked the bag and found heavy steel items, the individual failed to give a clear explanation of the origin of the items. The items were confiscated.

Both drivers went to the Police Station to complete an accident report.

**TUESDAY 14/12/2021**

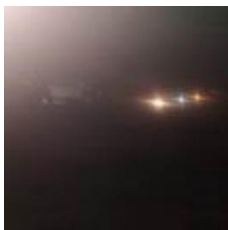


**DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT**
