MONDAY 03/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Street Lights

At approximately **22:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported faulty streets lights in Christian Avenue and Dacres Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller logged a service request on City of Cape Town's website and received a reference number.



MONDAY 24/01/2022

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Drain-Missing Cover

At approximately **13:10** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a missing drain cover in Packer Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted City of Cape Town and was given a reference number.

WEDNESDAY 05/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Drains-Blocked

At approximately **10:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed 2 blocked drains in Bofors Circle. An ECID CCTV Controller called City of Cape Town and received reference numbers.

THURSDAY 06/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Leakage-Water Valve

At approximately **14:55** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a leaking water valve in Benbow Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted City of Cape Town and was given a reference number.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Fire

At approximately **15:11** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a fire on the field opposite Kinghall Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and an ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue who responded and extinguished the fire.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Public Assistance

At approximately **09:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by a member of public requesting assistance with a violent individual in Benbow Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival, it was alleged that the individual was throwing stones at passing cars and assaulting/harassing the members of public walking by. The ECID Public Safety Officers noticed that the individual seems to have mental problems as he could not give clear answers. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, who requested that the ECID Public Safety Officers monitor the individual to prevent injuries or damages.

FRIDAY 28/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Business Assistance

At approximately **23:50** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a company in Christian Avenue reporting an employee who had collapsed. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and found the employee still conscious and contacted EMS. The individual was taken to hospital.

MONDAY 17/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Suspicious Vehicle-Monitored

At approximately 07:20 an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a truck stuck on Bofors Circle.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, the truck driver confirmed that the truck's engine just cut out and he was waiting on a mechanic.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately 20:23 an ECID Public Safety Officer responded to an accident in Elliott Avenue, a vehicle collided with a wall and was subsequently towed away. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAP and EMS.

SUNDAY 09/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Motor Vehicle Accident involving a Motor Bike

At approximately **09:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer notice an accident between a motor vehicle and a motorcycle on Bofors Circle between Bertie and Christian Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controllers contacted SAPS and EMS. The motorcycle driver sustained injuries and was taken to hospital.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Hit and Run

At approximately 16:15 an ECID Public Safety Officer spotted a group of people in front of the truck stop in Bofors Circle and proceeded to investigate, he found a pedestrian that was involved in a hit and run incident. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS and EMS, the patient was taken to Tygerberg Hospital.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Workers in Area doing Repairs & Maintenance

At approximately **09:44** an ECID CCTV Controller noticed a construction company working in Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and spoke to the supervisor who confirmed that they came to install fibre.

SUNDAY 23/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Black Bin Searched / Confiscated

At approximately **13:57** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted three suspicious individuals wandering around behind the Dacres rail siding. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on arrival the three individuals were cautiously searched and the black bin was confiscated. The individuals were escorted out of the area.

SATURDAY 01/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Attempted Theft-Yard-Warning

At approximately **11:17** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a suspicious person trying to enter a company in Benbow Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officer were dispatched, the suspect was detained and search, no suspected stolen items was in his possession. The suspect was escorted out of the area and was given a stern warning.



SUNDAY 02/01/2022

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Attempted Theft-Yard-Warning

At approximately **13:20** an ECID Public Safety Officer spotted two suspicious individuals removing pavement bricks, the individuals were in possession of a spade and shovel. The tools and bricks were confiscated and the suspects were escorted out of the area and given a stern warning.

TUESDAY 18/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Attempted Theft-Yard

At approximately **02:07** ECID Public Safety Officers noticed broken slabs at a company in Moorsom Avenue, they called for backup. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival the ECID Public Safety Officers met with the site security officer who confirmed that three suspects broke the slabs and ran away when they saw the ECID Public Safety Officers. SAPS arrived on scene shortly after. Nothing was stolen and the matter was handed over to the site security.

THURSDAY 27/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Attempted Theft-Building

At approximately **02:56** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an open door at one of the units in Evans Avenue. The site security officer was notified and confirmed that at approximately **02:34** the alarm system went off and two suspects came rushing out from the back of the building. The client confirmed that nothing was stolen only the padlock was cut. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, the tools that was found on the scene were confiscated.

THURSDAY 13/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Theft-Road

At approximately **18:19** and ECID Public Safety Officer received a call informing him about 4 suspicious individuals stealing drain covers in Nourse Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival the suspects drove off. The ECID Public Safety Officers gave chase but the suspects fled into Langa.

THURSDAY 20/01/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Theft-Building

At approximately **02:12** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a broken window at a company in Moorsom Avenue and called for backup. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on arrival they met with the site security officer and requested that he check the premises. The site security officer confirmed that the CCTV monitor and company phone were stolen. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived and attended the scene.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Theft-Yard

At approximately **08:45** an ECID Public Safety Officer attended to a complaint in Hewett Avenue. The complainant informed him about an unknown pickup vehicle that entered the premises on Monday 17th January at approximately 21:55, the driver and crew pretended to be employees and they stole a company tool box. The security on duty failed the register the vehicle, the complainant was advised to lay a criminal charge with SAPS.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT Armed Robbery

At approximately **05:12** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed three individuals on the buffer opposite Moorsom Avenue. One of the individuals was armed and ordered the ECID Public Safety Officer to open the door. The ECID Public Safety Officer tried to start the vehicle, the one individual broke the window with a hammer. The ECID Public Safety Officer complied with the request, the officer and vehicle were searched and his property was stolen. The ECID Public Safety Officer reported the incident to SAPS.
