Dumping

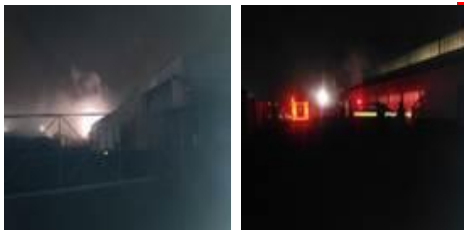


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **01:42** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a fire on the buffer between Bofors Circle and the Bonteheuwel railway lines. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, an ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue. Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene and managed to extinguish the fire.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Smoke

At approximately **00:01** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed smoke emanating from a company in Nourse Avenue, an ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue as well as the client. Fire and Rescue arrived and gained entry into the building and found the location of the smoke, they confirmed that there was not fire.

Workers in the Area

At approximately **10:21** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed construction workers in Benbow Avenue, he spoke to the supervisor who confirmed that they are from the City of Cape Town and came to fix the potholes.

Trolley Confiscated

At approximately **10:02** the ECID Public Safety Liaison Officer informed an ECID Public Safety Officer about an individual pushing a trolley in Gunners Circle going in the direction of Evans Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and the trolley was confiscated.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Motor Vehicle Accident-Involving a Cyclist

At approximately **07:58** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a telephone call from the member of public informing him about an accident that occurred on Bofors Circle, where a cyclist was hit by a motor vehicle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, an ECID CCTV Controller contacted EMS and SAPS, both responded quickly. A reckless and negligent driving case was opened and the patient was taken to the hospital.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Motor Vehicle Accident-Hit and Run

At approximately **19:35** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a motor vehicle that seemed to be stuck on the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Gunners Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched to investigate, on his arrival Law Enforcement and SAPS were already on the scene. The complainant was approaching the intersection when an unknown vehicle drove into the back of his vehicle and drove off. Accident report was completed by SAPS.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Damaged to ECID Property

At approximately **08:45** ECID Public Safety Officers reported that Bofors / Goodenough siding gate had fallen down. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and loaded the gate on the vehicle, it was taken to 24 Gunners for safekeeping.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **04:45** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from the complainant in Gunners Circle requesting ECID assistance. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and on arrival he met with the complainant who alleged that one of the customers bumped his bakkie and requested the ECID Public Safety Officer's assistance in obtaining the details of the driver of the other vehicle. The information was given and both involved parties left the scene with their vehicles. No police were requested.

WEDNESDAY 23/03/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident-Involving Pedestrian

At approximately **07:35** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported an accident that occurred in Gunners Circle in front of Shell Garage where a pedestrian was knocked by a vehicle. The ECID Public Safety Officer gathered information while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, Fire and Rescue as well as EMS. The pedestrian was certified and declared dead on the scene. SAPS opened a criminal case of reckless and negligent driving for further investigation. The forensic pathology arrived and took the body to the state mortuary.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Suspicious Vehicle

At approximately **14:40** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from the ECID Manager asking about a vehicle that was stuck next to the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Viking Way. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched and met with the owner of the vehicle who confirmed that he had a flat tyre and was waiting for the supplier, whom arrived and the problem was resolved.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Suspicious Vehicle-Wanted Vehicle

At approximately **12:24** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed the bakkie reported to be used in Epping for other notorious criminal activities and reported this to the control room. The ECID CCTV Controllers tried to locate the bakkie on the CCTV cameras. SAPS has also reported the same bakkie allegedly related to other criminal activities in Thornton. The bakkie managed to escape due to the speed limit and drove to Valhalla Drive.

SUNDAY 13/03/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT
Suspicious Vehicle-Wanted Vehicle

At approximately **20:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported the old white Nissan bakkie wanted for the theft at OWA, driving from Langa into Epping 1 near the Jakes Gerwel Drive and Gunners Circle intersection. An ECID CCTV Controller monitored the bakkie while another ECID CCTV Controllers contacted SAPS. The bakkies drove towards Thornton, SAPS tried to stop the bakkie and were unsuccessful and the bakkie got away and drove off towards Elsie's River.

Suspected Stolen Goods Recovered-Warning

At approximately **08:43** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted 2 individuals in the Bertie / Bofors rail siding removing items and loading the items on a flat trolley. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, the ECID Public Safety Officers approached and searched the individuals. The ECID Public Safety Officers found pieces of Aluminium and the individuals could not give a clear explanation of where they found the items. The items were confiscated and the individuals were warned and escorted out of the area.

Suspicious persons-Searched-Waring

At approximately **00:55** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted 2 suspicious individuals wondering on the rail siding behind Benbow Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and, on their arrival, the individuals were approached and searched, nothing suspicious was found on their possession. Both individuals were warned and escorted out of the area.

Attempted Smash and Grab

At approximately **12:10** An ECID CCTV Controller spotted 5 suspicious individuals who seem to be smash and grabbers. The instruction was then given to reposition the ECID kiosk to be positioned near Langa bridge.

Attempted Theft-Road

While ECID Public Safety Officers were talking to them they dropped the drain cover and drove off.
