SUNDAY 17/04/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **20:44** an ECID vehicle and a vehicle from another security company were involved in an accident at the intersection of Jakes Gerwel Drive and Bofors Circle where the security vehicle did not stop at the red traffic light and hit the ECID vehicle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched. The driver of the security vehicle was slightly injured but he did not request an ambulance. The security vehicle was towed away.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **12:50** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from the ECID Manager reporting a fire on the field between Christian and Bertie Avenues. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted Fire and Rescue who responded and extinguished the fire before it could cause damage to nearby premises.

DISCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Illegal Structure Removed

At approximately **20:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed and reported an illegal structure that was erected near Langa Station. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted Law Enforcement to assist with the removal of the illegal structure and was given a refence number. At approximately **23:50** a Law Enforcement inspector arrived and spoke with the owner of the structure who was issued with a warning, the owner was informed that they will come to remove the structure if the owner did not remove it within 24hrs. On Monday **04/04/2022** at approximately **12:00** Law Enforcement arrived and took pictures of the structure and confirmed that the matter will be referred to Land Invasion. On **Friday 22/04/2022** at approximately **10:20** the ECID Public Safety Liaison Officer and ECID Public Safety Officers went to the place and spoke with the owner of the illegal structure who cooperated and asked ECID Public Safety Officers to assist him to break down the structure as he is going back to his home.

Leakage-Overflowing Drain

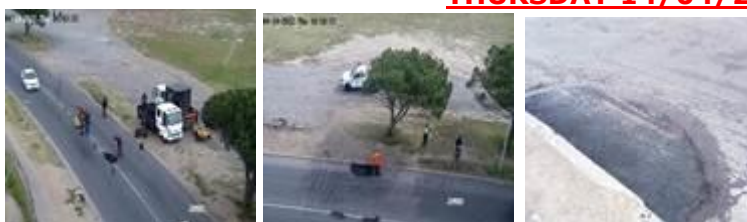


DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

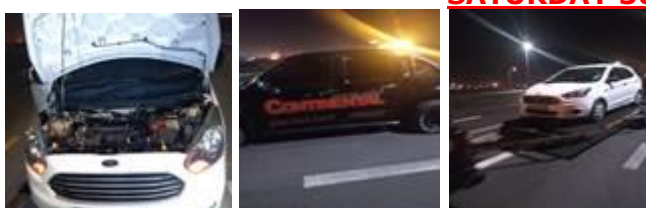

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft Building-Arrest

At approximately **14:51** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a complainant who requested assistance with a suspect who was trying to break in at a company in Nourse Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival they met with the complainant who pointed to them in the direction of the suspect. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS, the ECID Public Safety Officers managed to apprehend the suspect. At approximately **15:00** SAPS arrived on the scene and the suspect was arrested.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Theft-Road-Recovery-Arrest

At approximately **22:01** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a complainant who requested urgent assistance with 2 suspects that they spotted stealing drain covers in Packer Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers responded and found the suspects in possession of CoCT drain covers, a knife and a crowbar. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on the scene at approximately **22:40** the suspects were handed over to the Police.

Theft Yard-Arrest

At approximately **07:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant at a company in Goodenough Avenue, who requested ECID assistance with a suspect that was caught stealing electrical wires and battery cables from their business premises. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived on the scene at approximately **07:50**. A criminal case was opened and the suspect was taken to the Police Station for detention.

Theft Building

ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, they met with the complainant who alleged that the incident took place at approximately **05:30** and some of his property was stolen, he will further check the following day so that he can open a case.

Armed Robbery

At approximately **13:00** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a security officer informing her about an armed robbery that took place at a wholesaler in Benbow Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS. It was confirmed that staff members were robbed of their cell phones at gun point, no cash was taken and no injuries were reported. SAPS opened a case.

Hijacking

At Approximately **16:00** an ECID Public Safety Officer was flagged down by a complainant who alleged that his taxi was hijacked near Moody Bridge by 4 suspects who pretended to be passengers. They took his Toyota Quantum, cell phone and wallet. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS who arrived shortly and took the complainant to the Police Station.
