

CCTV REPORT- JUNE 2022

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022

DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Attempted Murder

At approximately **16h12** an ECID Controller received a call from an anonymous person who reported a shooting on Gunners Circle. ECID Public Safety CCTV Controller focused the cameras to the scene while ECID CCTV Controllers were busy contacting SAPS. ECID Public Safety Officers responded to the scene and noticed that 1 male who was bleeding from the head but still alive. They then cornered off the scene in order to protect the scene. There was a number of cartridges laying around. The patient that the sustained head injury was transported to Groote Schuur Hospital. No suspect was identified. Five mini bus taxis including a Toyota Avanza that was involved in the shooting were impounded by SAPS.

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Sudden Death

At approximately **10h00** while patrolling Gunners Circle, an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed Pinelands SAPS standing down in Gunners Circle. Upon arrival they met with the SAPS who confirmed that a customer had collapsed and passed away. At approximately **11h00** Forensics arrived to determine if there was any foul play. At approximately **11h45** the deceased was taken to Salt River Mortuary.

THURSDAY 02 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Business Assistance-Arrest

At approximately **05h15** an urgent message was received by an ECID Public Safety Officer that assistance is needed at a fuel station about a suspect who jumped into the property and tried to rob the security. ECID Public Safety Officers responded to the address, upon arrival the suspect was detained by the security on site. Searching was cautiously conducted on the suspect but no suspicious items were found on his possession. Elsie's River SAPS unfortunately failed to arrive so the owner insisted that he will take the suspect to the Police Station personally.

THURSDAY 16 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Overflowing Sewer

At approximately **15h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed an overflowing sewer on Bofors Circle. A service request was created on the City of Cape Town's website and a reference number was generated.

SUNDAY 19 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Theft Building

At approximately **09h45** while ECID Public Safety Officers were patrolling at Wembley Centre, they reported that they were flagged down by a client alleging that there was a break-in at his shop at Wembley Centre. The incident happened the previous night. The suspect(s) broke two windows and grabbed some trays of burgers and sausages that were in the fridge next to the window. The owner advised he will fix the damages and has no interest to call the police.

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Theft-Yard / Road

At approximately **11h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer was conducting his patrol in Agric Street when he was approached by a Supervisor from a business. He informed the Officer about a theft that occurred the previous night, two gate motors were allegedly stolen. The Supervisor said he will inform his employer to contact the SAPS to report the matter.

TUESDAY 28 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Attempted Theft-Building

At approximately **00h22** ECID quad bike drivers reported that while they were patrolling past Gerry Ferry Crescent when they noticed two suspicious persons run out of the back door of a premises.

Back up was called and ECID Public Safety Officers responded to the address, on arrival there were no suspects as they ran in the direction of the Informal Market. They noticed the safety gate was cut open to gain access inside. An ECID Controller contacted the client and ADT Armed Response. At **01h09** ADT arrived and checked the property, it appeared as if nothing was taken as the safety gate was cut but the door was still closed.

ADT control confirmed that they were unable to make contact with the client and that they will keep an eye on the place until they can contact the owner.

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Theft-Yard / Road

At approximately **13h45** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from the ECID Shift Leader informing him about a theft that occurred on the field at Christian Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers responded to gather information, on arrival they met with the complainant who advised that two truck batteries were stolen off the back of a truck. The suspect jumped onto the trailer while the driver stopped at the stop sign, the suspect grabbed the batteries and ran off. As the suspect had fled already the scene there was no further action taken by the PSOs. The complainant will raise the issue with his supervisor.

THURSDAY 09 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

Leak

Approximately **22h40** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed a pipe leaking in Gunners Circle near Cochrane Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted City of Cape Town and a reference number was given.

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

Fire

At approximately **00h33** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call about a fire at a building in Nourse Avenue, where smoke was already rising from the roof. Fire and Rescue was contacted and they arrived immediately, the Fire and Rescue team had to cut the padlock on the gate to gain access to the premises as the client had not arrived on site at the time. The fire was successfully extinguished by the firemen, no injuries were reported. The client advised that he'll stay on site till the morning as the roller shutter door was damaged. The cause of the fire will be investigated but they suspect electrical fault at the wall plugs.

FRIDAY 24 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Attempted Theft Yard / Road-Arrest

At approximately **01h20** the ECID Shift Leader received a phone call from a gentlemen in Benbow Avenue informing him about a suspect that was on his premises trying to steal from the property. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival they met with the complainant who pointed them in the direction of the suspect whom they successfully apprehended. Pinelands SAPS arrived at approximately **01h46** and the suspect was handed over to them.

SATURDAY 11 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Possession of Suspected Stolen Items

At approximately **08h00** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted three suspects carrying heavy items on the railway tracks. The ECID Public Safety Officers managed to apprehend 2 of the suspects but the third managed to flee. The suspects were in possession of scrap metal, they wouldn't disclose where they obtained the items. The suspects were escorted out of the area and the scrap confiscated.

TUESDAY 21 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Suspicious Persons

At approximately **02h21** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted 2 suspicious persons wandering behind a premises, it appeared as if they were planning to jump inside. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on arrival the suspicious persons were spotted and questioned about their intentions. They had no answer to offer, a search was conducted and nothing suspicious was found on their possession besides a knife. The knife was confiscated and taken to office; the two suspects were escorted out of the area.

FRIDAY 03 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **10h30** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a member of the public reporting an accident in Bofors Circle. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched, on his arrival he confirmed that a female pedestrian was knocked by a vehicle. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted the Emergency Services, Elsie's SAPS and Fire and Rescue Services. At approximately **11h01** Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene, the patient was taken to Vanguard Day Hospital.

FRIDAY 10 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **16h20** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported a vehicle accident between 2 vehicles on the corner of Agric Street and Techno Crescent in Western Province Park. Both drivers shared personal information, there were no injuries and the ECID Public Safety Officers assisted with traffic control. The parties decided not to open a case, since the vehicle only had a small scratch.

THURSDAY 16 JUNE 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **17h45** ECID Public Safety Officers spotted a car that drove into a wall near the main entrance of the premises in Bofors Circle. The driver was distracted by a truck that was going into the property to offload. No injuries were reported and the vehicle was towed to the owner's address.
