

CCTV REPORT-MAY 2022

WEDNESDAY 04/05/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Fire

At approximately **14:05** an ECID Public Safety Officer spotted 2 men on the field opposite Packer Avenue lighting a fire and when approached by the ECID Public Safety Officer, they quickly ran off. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted Epping Fire and Rescue, who extinguished the fire.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Workers in Epping

At approximately **09:32** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted a construction company in Gunners Circle, an ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched, he met with the supervisor who confirmed that they are from CoCT and they came to replace the broken drain slabs in the area.

SUNDAY 15/05/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Dumping

At approximately **11:15** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported dumping in Bofors Circle. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted City of Cape Town and received a reference number.

TUESDAY 31/05/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Theft-Rail siding

At approximately **10:55** ECID Public Safety Officers noticed and reported the theft of the small gate at one of the rail sidings.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Missing drain cover

At approximately **08:16** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a phone call from a complainant at the corner of Bofors Circle and Nourse Avenue, who reported a stolen drain cover. An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched while an ECID CCTV Controller completed a CoCT service request and received a reference number.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Wheelie Bin Confiscated

At approximately **00:05** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted 2 suspicious individuals pushing a black wheelie bin in Bofors Circle. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and arrived within minutes. The black wheelie bin was searched and no suspicious items were found, wheelie bin was confiscated and taken to the ECID office.



SUNDAY 15/05/2022

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Public Assistance

At approximately **13:13** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed and reported a stationary vehicle in Bofors Circle. He noticed the driver moving irregularly inside the vehicle. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted EMS at 13:20, the EMS medical care team arrived and confirmed that the driver had a seizure. Metro Police Officers arrived and due to the driver not being fit to drive, they accompanied him home.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Motor Vehicle Accident-Arrest

At approximately **14:59** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed, reported and attended to an accident on the corner of Gunners Circle and Fisher Avenue where 2 motor vehicles were involved. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted the EMS and SAPS due to injured passengers. Fire and Rescue, SAPS and EMS arrived on the scene where the driver of the one vehicle was arrested and the injured passengers were taken to the hospital. Both vehicles were towed away from the scene.

MONDAY 23/05/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Motor Vehicle Accident Involving a Pedestrian

At approximately **09:30** an ECID Public Safety Officer reported an accident in Bofors Circle on top of the bridge where a male pedestrian was knocked by a truck.

An ECID Public Safety Officer was dispatched to assist, an ECID CCTV Controller contacted EMS, SAPS as well as Fire and Rescue Services. At approximately **09:45** SAPS and Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene. The EMS team arrived at **10:35** and took the patient to hospital.

WEDNESDAY 04/05/2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Suspicious People

At approximately **20:03** an ECID Public Safety Officer noticed and reported a large number of people digging trenches opposite Gunners Park in Gunners Circle, causing water from the drain to flow into the road. The ECID Public Safety Officer called for back-up and members on duty arrived within minutes, they met with leader who informed then that the over flowing drain on the open field is getting into their houses. They were instructed not to dig trenches as it is the City of Cape Town's Water and Sanitation department's job. At **20:56** Pinelands SAPS also came to assist. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted CoCT Water and Sanitation department and was issued with a reference number. The group of people stopped digging and went back to Langa.



WEDNESDAY 18/05/2022

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Recovery of Stolen Property

At approximately **05:04** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a call from a complainant who requested assistance at the Truck Stop, he reported that two suspects broke into a truck and stole a gas stove. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, the two suspects were spotted on the railway tracks. They were detained and had the stolen gas stove in their possession, the suspects were handed over to CTM security.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Hit and Run-Death

At approximately **06:08** an ECID CCTV Controller spotted Metro Police vehicles on Langa Bridge. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on arrival they found a hit and run victim who had already passed away. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted his employer and they dispatched their duty manager to identify the person. At approximately **09:30** the forensic pathologist arrived on the scene and the body was taken to the mortuary.



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Theft-Building

At approximately **07:20** an ECID CCTV Controller received a phone call from a complainant in Gunners Circle requesting ECID Assistance. ECID Public Safety Officers responded, on their arrival the complainant reported theft from his shop. The complainant confirmed that he phoned SAPS, SAPS did not arrive on the scene and the complainant will go to report the

incident to SAPS. FRIDAY 06/05/2022

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Theft Road-Arrest

At approximately **00:20** an ECID Public Safety Officer caught a suspect stealing a drain cover in Benbow Avenue. An ECID CCTV Controller contacted Pinelands SAPS and they arrived at approximately **00:25**. An arrest was made and the suspect was taken to the Police Station. **THURSDAY 12/05/2022**



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT: Armed Robbery

At approximately **05:20** an ECID Public CCTV Controller received a call requesting ECID assistance with their security site manager that was shot on Bofors Circle by an unknown suspect. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted EMS, Fire and Rescue and SAPS. On arrival of the ECID Public Safety Officers it was confirmed by the victim that he was approached by 3 suspicious individuals, one of the suspects fired 3 bullets, one bullet struck him in the left lower leg. The suspects robbed him of his bag. At approximately **07:00** SAPS arrived on the scene and at approximately **07:05** Fire and Rescue arrived on the scene. After statements were taken, the victim was taken to hospital for medical attention by his manager.
