TUESDAY 02 AUGUST 2022



DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Suspicious Person

At approximately **08h57**, a CCTV Assistant Controller spotted a suspicious male busy cutting off wires at the buffer opposite Evans Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched to attend and instructed him to leave the area. The trolley and wires were confiscated and taken to the office.

DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Leakage-Sewerage

At approximately **11:00** the ECID Administrator notified ECID Public Safety Officer about an overflowing sewer drain in Grenville Avenue. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched to check and confirmed that there is a leakage at 2 drains. The ECID Public Safety Officer created a C3 notification and a reference number was generated.

Theft in Building

Theft Yard / Road

At approximately **10:38** An ECID CCTV Controller spotted 5 suspicious individuals in the rails behind Jellicoe Avenue, 1 of the individuals was inside a business premises. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched and found the individuals in possession of suspected stolen property. The ECID Public Safety Officers escorted the individuals to the client and the client confirmed that they are not interested in opening the case. The individuals were warned and escorted out of the area.

Damage to Property

At approximately **04:24** an ECID Public Safety Officer received a telephone call regarding suspicious individuals in Nourse Avenue. ECID Public Safety Officers were dispatched, on their arrival they noticed the individuals in the road. Suddenly the individuals started throwing stones at the ECID bakkie and damaged the right mirror as well as the window of 12 Nourse Avenue. The individuals ran to Bonteheuwel and the ECID Public Safety Officer went to the Police Station to open a case.

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **01:14** an ECID CCTV Officer noticed a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Viking Way and Showground. An ECID Public Safety Officer was sent to assist while an ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS. The driver of one of the vehicles left his vehicle on the scene and ran away. SAPS arrived on the scene and completed an accident report. No injuries were reported.

Motor Vehicle Accident

At approximately **07:49** An ECID CCTV Controller spotted an accident that occurred at the intersection of Viking Way and Sipres Road. ECID Public Safety Officers arrived to gather the information where they confirmed that it was hit and run but there were no injuries. The vehicle was then towed away.

FRIDAY 26 AUGUST 2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Attempted Smash and Grab

At approximately **08:19** An ECID CCTV Controller spotted 3 suspicious individuals on Langa Bridge. An ECID Public Safety Officer was despatched and when he approached the bridge the 3 individuals ran away to Langa informal settlement. Smash and grab was prevented and no incident was reported.

TUESDAY 30 AUGUST 2022



DESCRIPTION OF THE INCIDENT

Dead Body Discovered

At approximately **06:10** An ECID CCTV Controller noticed a number of individuals on Langa Bridge and he sent ECID Public Safety Officers to investigate. On arrival they found an unresponsive individual. The ECID CCTV Controller contacted SAPS and EMS, who arrived on the scene and the individual was declared dead. SAPS opened an inquest docket and the body was taken by the Forensic Pathology to the state morgue. There appeared to be no foul play involved, it was suggested that the person could have possibly frozen to death during the night.
